
Granma wins championship of Cuba's 60th Baseball Season




Sancti Spíritus, April 4 (RHC)-- With Guillermo García's hit in the ninth inning, Granma shattered the odds and defeated Matanzas by a score of 6 to 5 on Sunday to become the champion of the 60th Baseball Series in Cuba.

In a tournament with no fans in the stadiums and under strict health measures to curb COVID-19, the Alazanes from Granma dethroned the Cocodrilos of Matanzas, kings a year earlier, and fulfilled the longing to reach the third title in the last five years, after getting the championship in 2017 and 2018.
