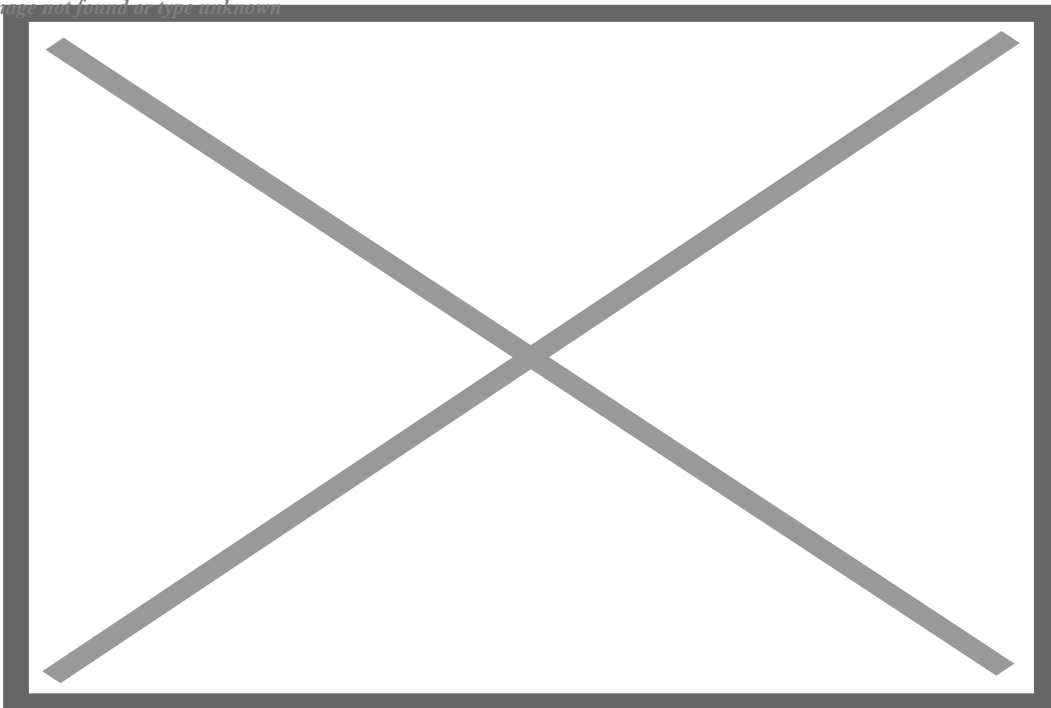


Cuban President recognizes the work of development workers in Mexico

Havana, April 15 (RHC)" Cuban President Miguel Díaz-Canel on Thursday recognized the work of the fifth group of health workers who returned to the country after facing Covid-19 in Mexico.

It is with immense pride that we receive you', said the president in a video message, in which he highlighted the arrival of the 92 professionals on the eve of the beginning of the Eighth Congress of the Communist Party of the Caribbean nation.
