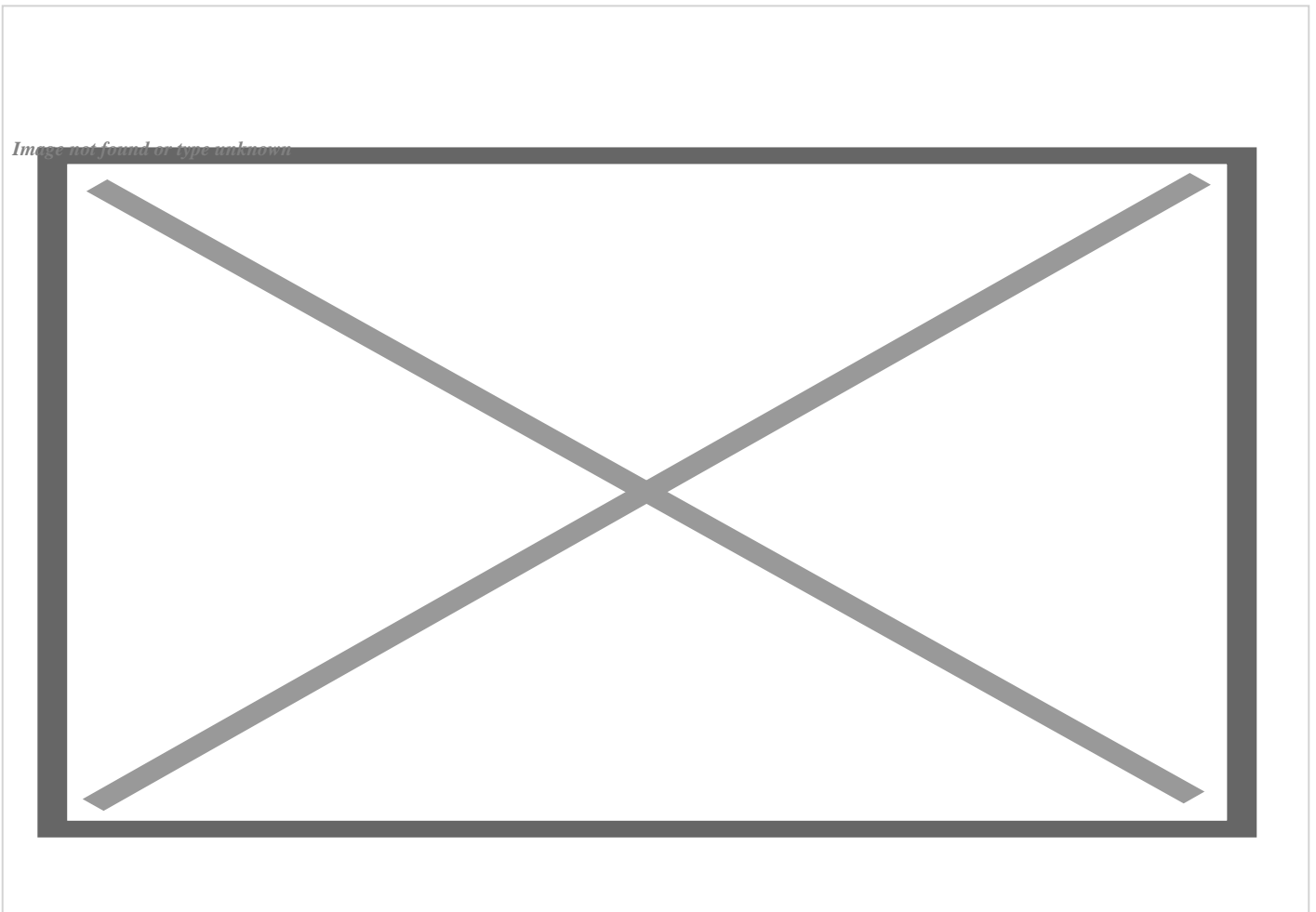


# *Organizations from all over the world salute meeting of Cuban communists*
