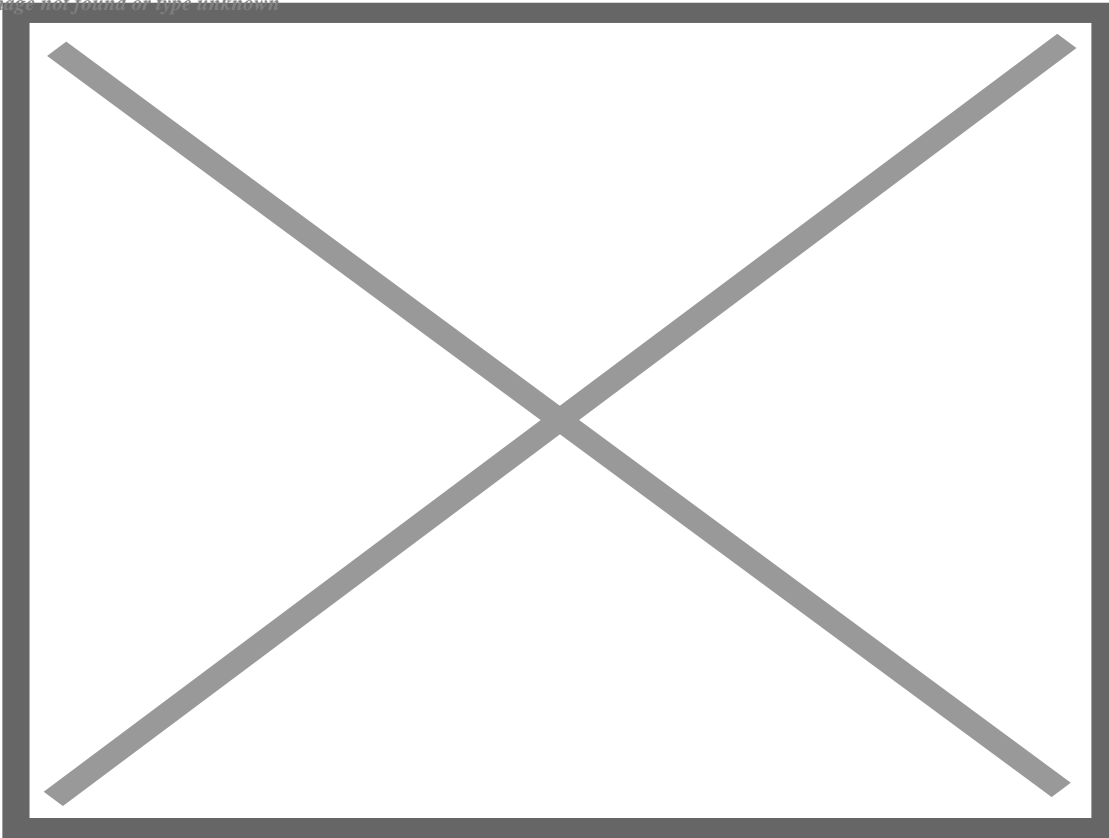


Cuba and Russia examine possible cooperation in the agro-industrial sector
