
Latin American nations suffer "worst moment" of coronavirus pandemic



Santiago de Chile, April 22 (RHC)-- In Latin America, Uruguay and Colombia are reporting record deaths this week, Brazil is averaging over 3,000 deaths a day, and Argentina just passed 60,000 deaths in a

year. Argentina's health minister called this week the "worst moment" of the pandemic.

In Turkey, Health Ministry data suggests about 1% of the working-age population — or more than a halfmillion people — currently has an active COVID-19 infection. Turkish officials have so far delivered about 20 million vaccine doses nationwide for a population of over 80 million people.
