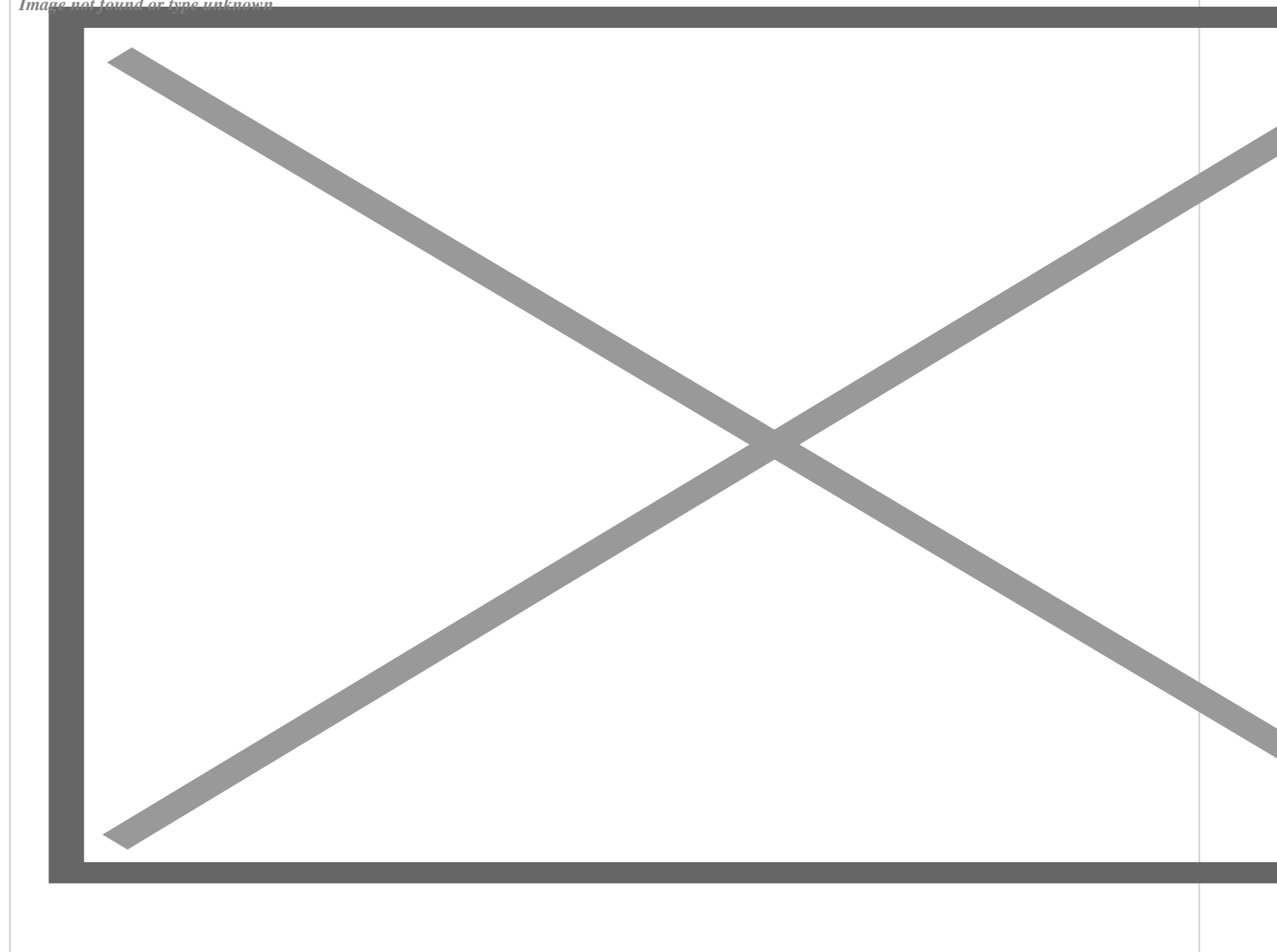


Cuba conveys condolences to Mexico on subway disaster

Havana, April 4 (RHC)—Cuba sent condolences to the people and government of Mexico for the loss of lives in an accident.

A Mexico City metro train overpass collapsed onto a road on Monday night, killing at least 23 people, including children, authorities said. Nearly 70 more were reportedly injured.

the island's Foreign Minister, Bruno Rodriguez Parrilla.
