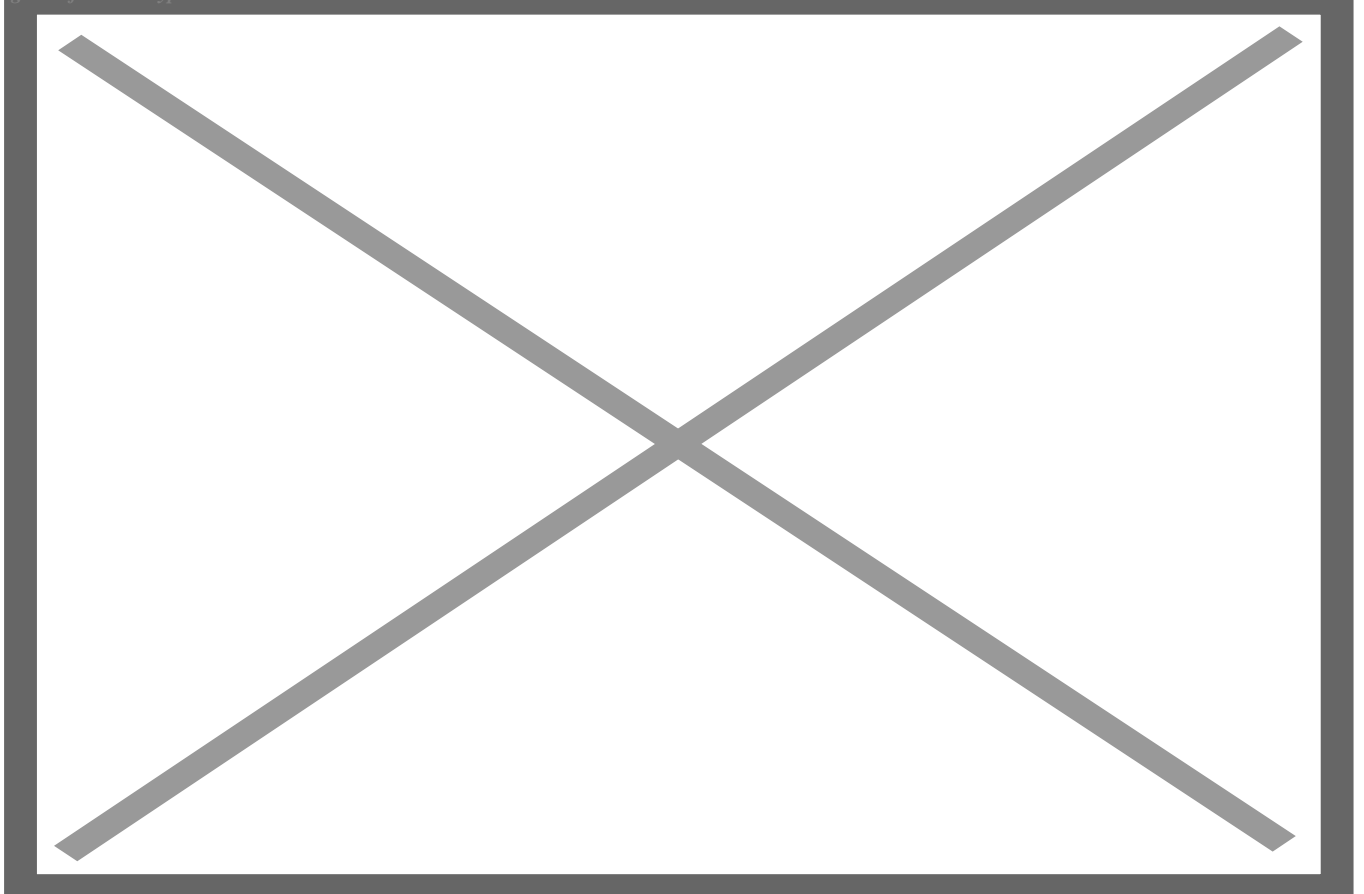


Díaz-Canel receives Executive Director of IFCO/Pastors for Peace
