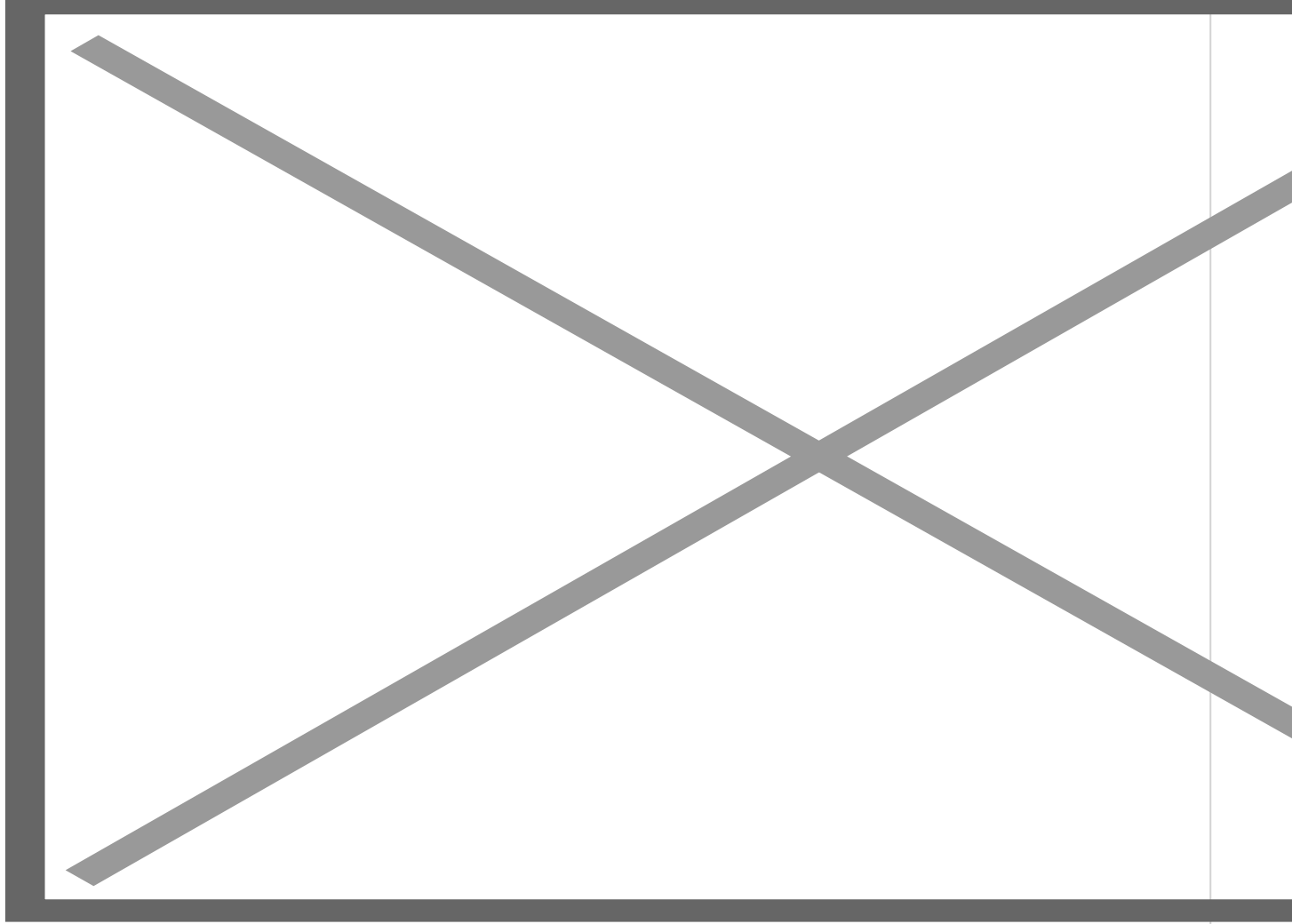


Malaysian Prime Minister Muhyiddin Yassin and cabinet steps down
