

Cuban President Welcomes Visiting Prime Minister of St. Kitts and Nevis



Havana, June 25 (RHC) -- Cuban President Raul Castro met Tuesday afternoon with Dr. Denzil Lewellyn Douglas, Prime Minister and Minister of Finances, Sustainable Development, Development of Human Resources, Empowerment and Social Security of the Federation of Saint Kitts and Nevis, who is on an official visit to Cuba.
