
Madagascar on brink of world's first climate change famine

Severe hunger and famine are being driven by drought, deforestation and desertification that's left over 1.1 million of Madagascar's residents in need of humanitarian assistance.

A World Food Program official called the situation unprecedented, adding: "These people have done nothing to contribute to climate change. They don't burn fossil fuels ... and yet they are bearing the brunt of climate change."
