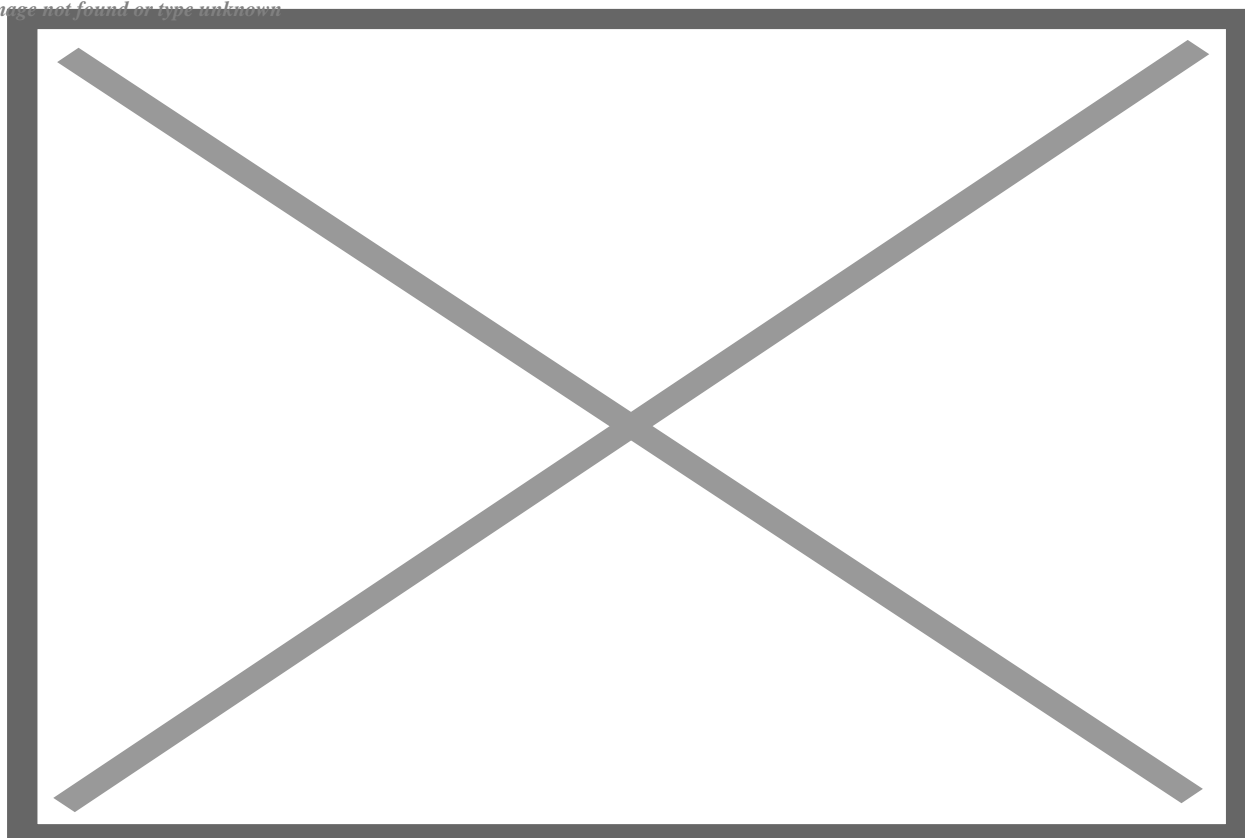


Cuba thanks Pope Francis for his good wishes
