
Havana ratifies commitment to South-South cooperation



Havana, September 12 (RHC) -- Foreign Minister Bruno Rodriguez on Sunday confirmed Cuba's commitment to South-South cooperation, which reflects the solidarity and humanist vocation of the Cuban people.
