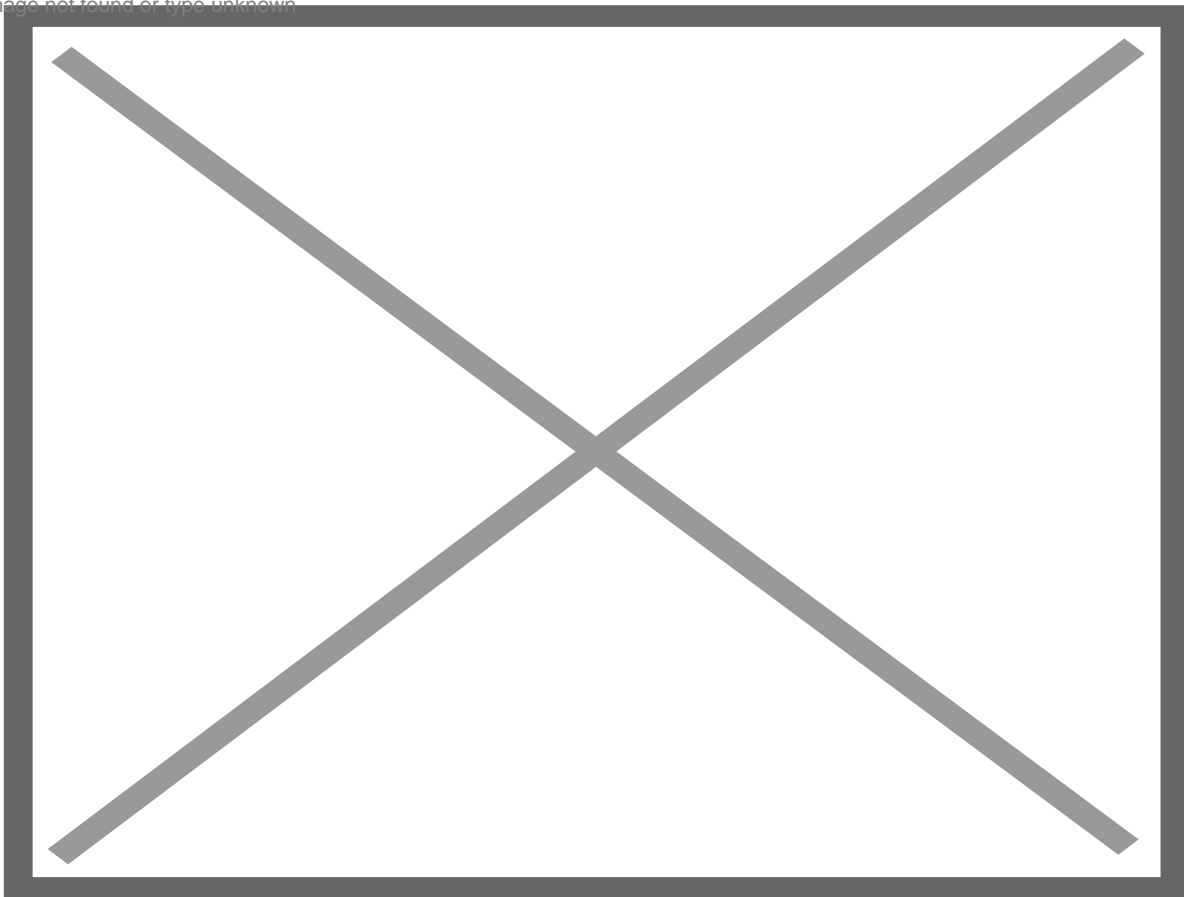


Cuban President receives Gail Walker, Pastors for Peace Director
