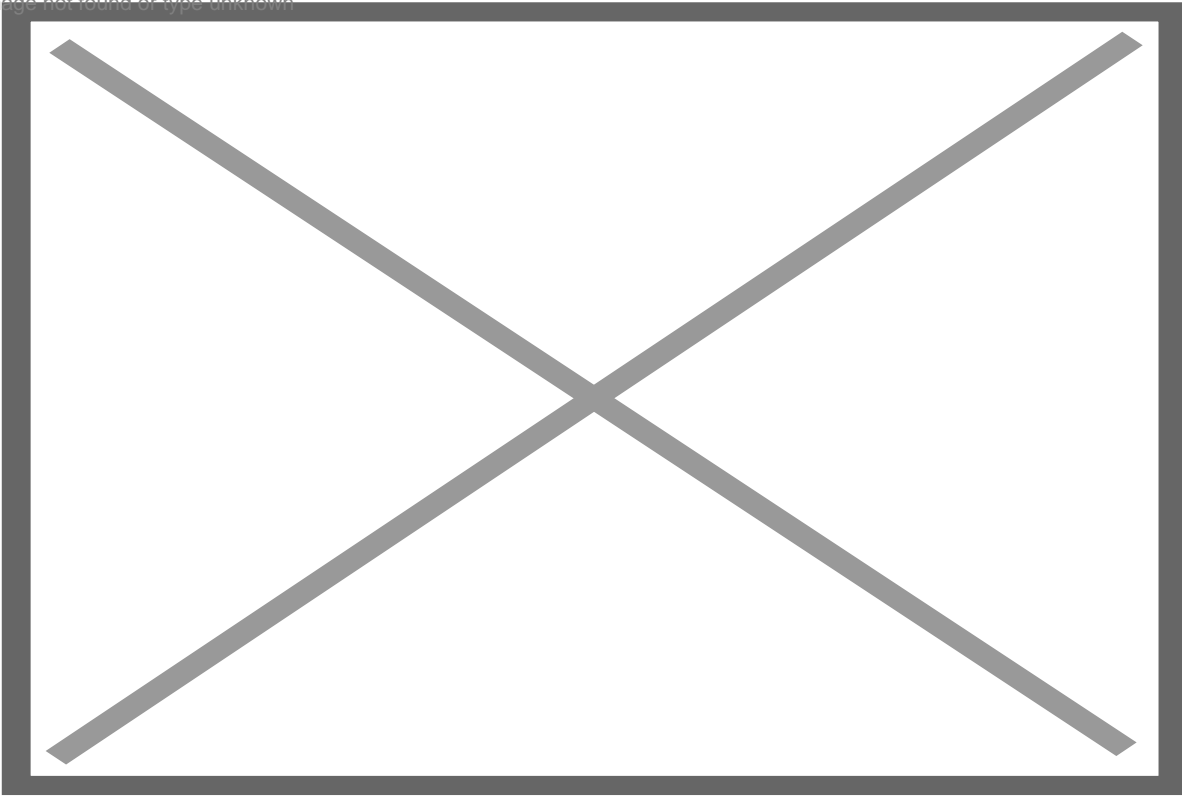


Díaz-Canel met with representatives of Mexican organizations in solidarity with Cuba
