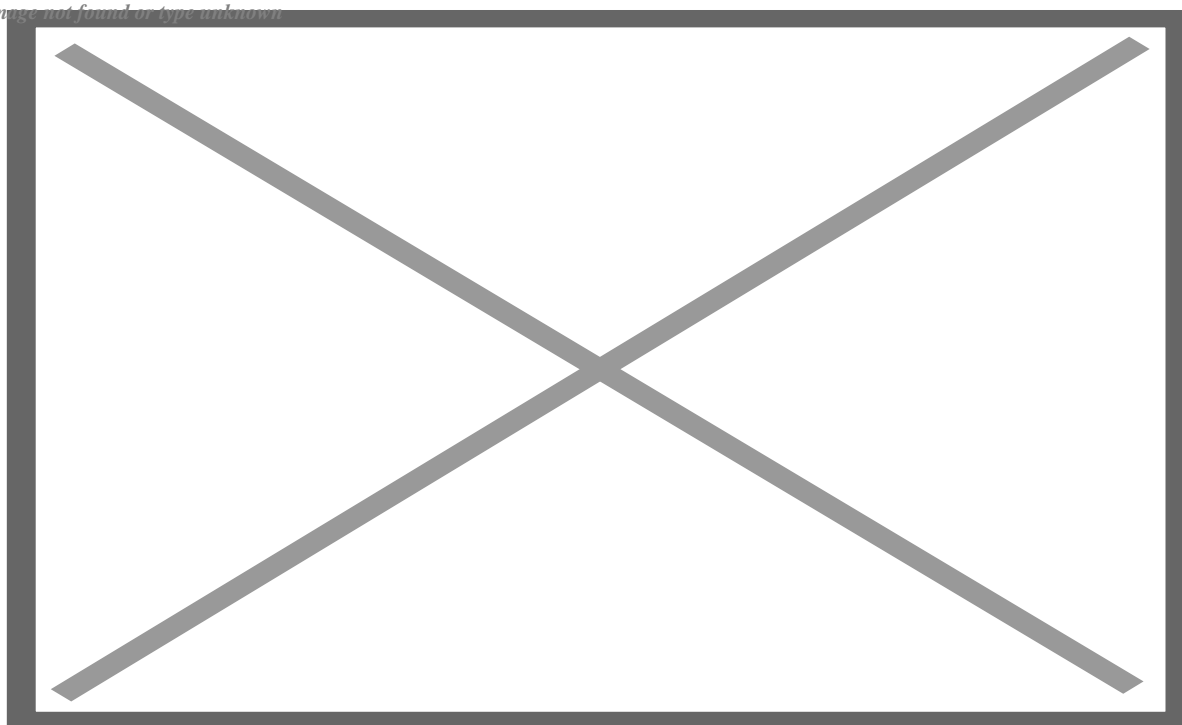


Cuba participates in UNESCO Interregional Workshop on Creative Economy and Geoparks

Havana, Sept 28 (RHC) Cuba is participating virtually in an interregional workshop of the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO), which aims to promote the relationship between creative economy and Global Geoparks.

Organized by the headquarters of this organization in Uruguay, this event was attended by officials from the Cuban National Commission for UNESCO (CNCU) and the Ministry of Energy and Mines.

To improve awareness and understanding of the key issues facing global society, this workshop takes place in the framework of the current year of the Creative Economy for Sustainable Development,

declared by the United Nations.
