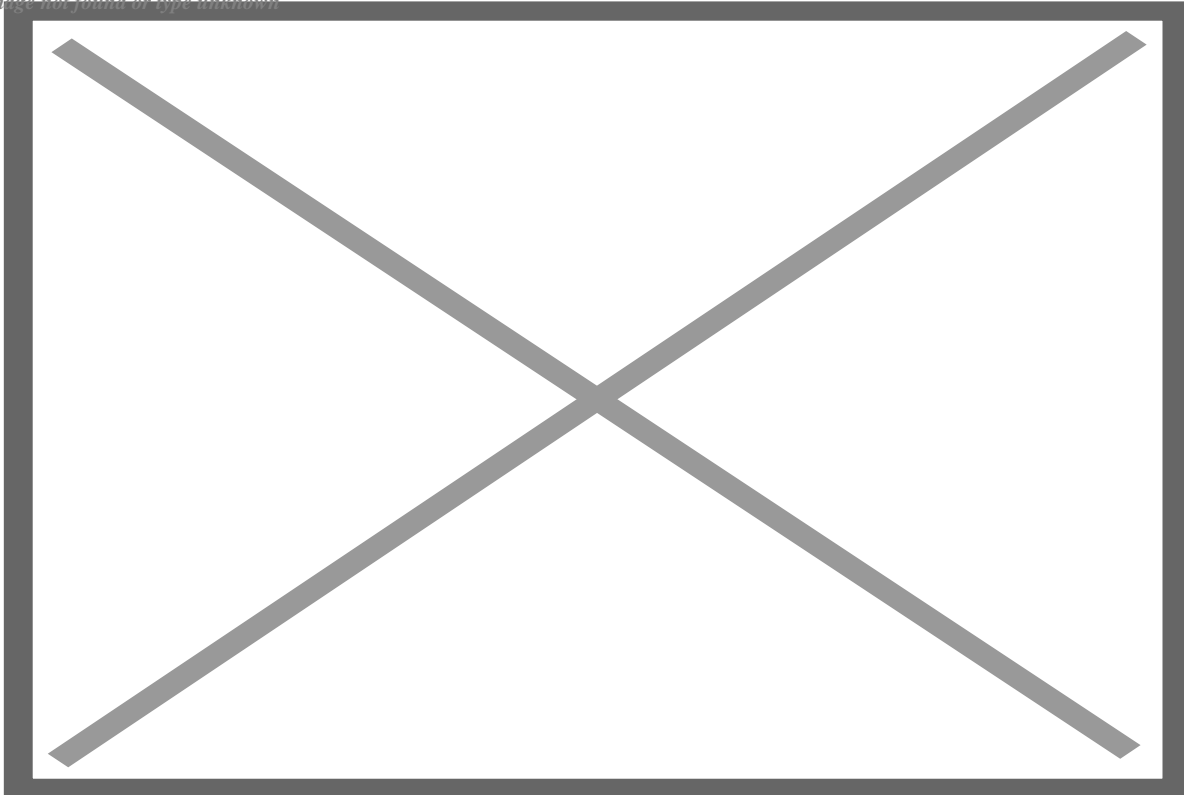


President hails Cuba's largest mass organization
