Madrid, October 19 (RHC(PL))-- The Spanish Movistar team officially presented Cuban cyclist Arlenis Sierra as one of its members for the next season of the international circuit.

On its website, the Spanish team said Monday that the Cuban, fifth in the World Road Race, is one of the most complete riders of the World Tour and her contribution will be vital for the team's results.

Meanwhile, Arlenis said she was very happy with her signing, thanked the confidence placed in her by the board and assured that she will make the most of the opportunity.
