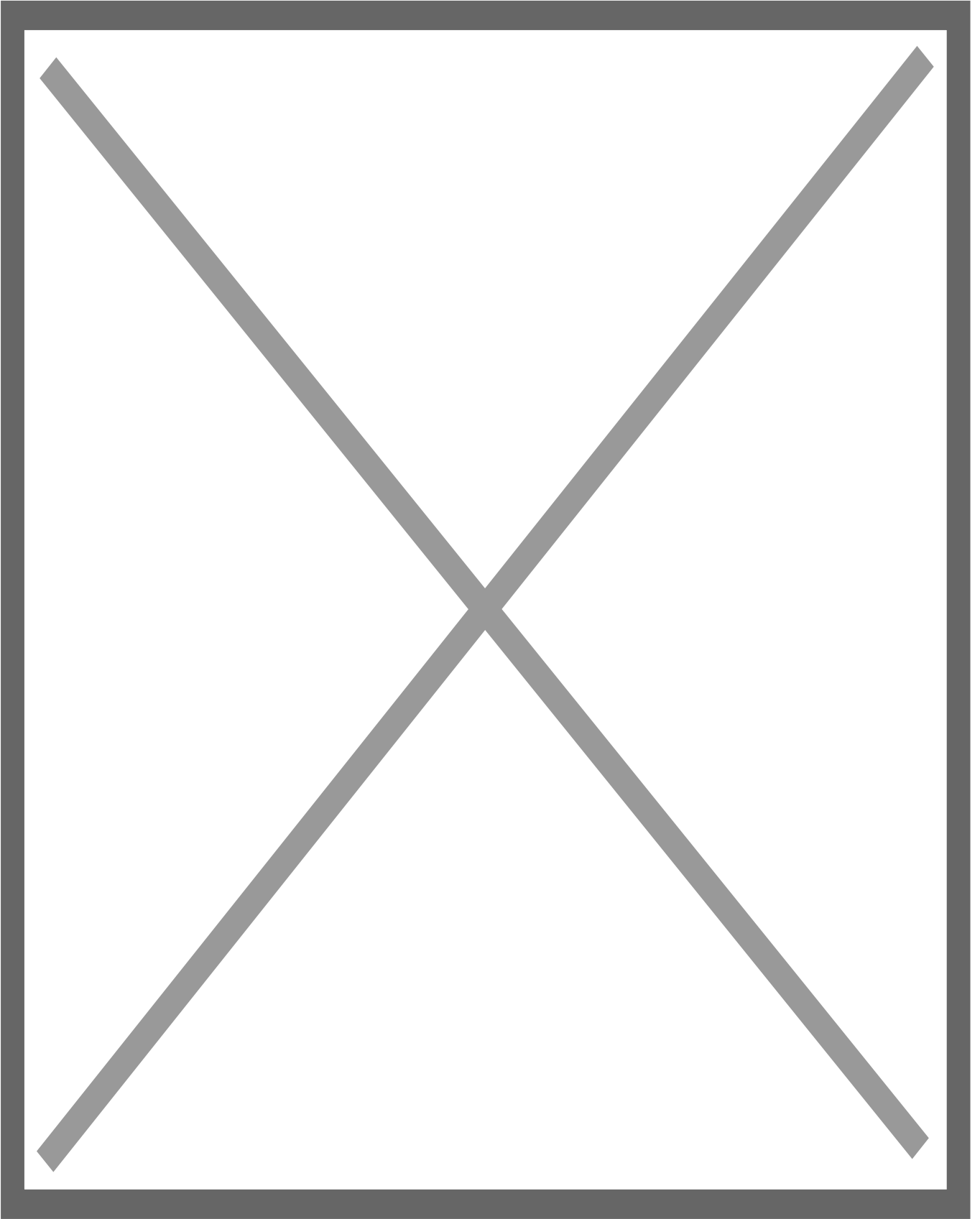


Canadian solidarity brigade visits Cuba

Havana, November 22 (RHC)-- The 27th Canadian Brigade 'Ernesto Che Guevara,' the first volunteer and solidarity brigade that Cuba has received in the new normal, is in Cuba.

On Sunday, brigade members visited the '28 de Septiembre' Service Complex, in the La Güinera neighborhood of Havana, where profound social transformations are taking place, led by its inhabitants under the guidance of the Government and the Communist Party.

The contingent is made up of 11 activists and will carry out volunteer work.
