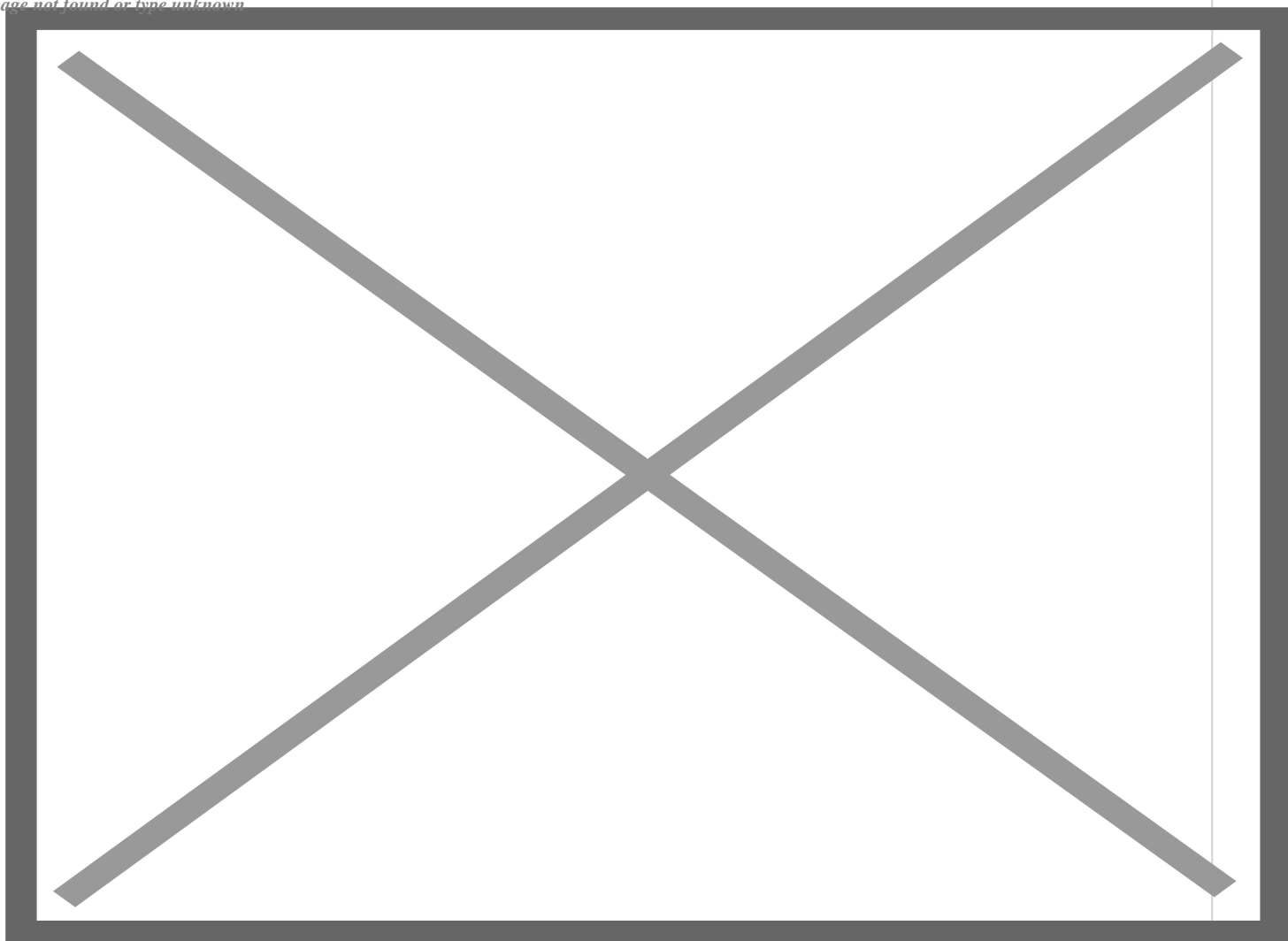


Karel Guzman bids farewell to 2021 at the Romanian Cup

Havana, December 30 (RHC)-- U-Banca Transilvania Cluj Napoca will bid farewell to the 2021 competitive activity this Thursday, at the Polivalente Pavilion, when it hosts Dinamo Bucuresti, in the second leg of the Romanian Basketball Cup.

The team in which Cuban Karel Guzmán plays won last Monday a close 72x68 victory in the first leg, a game that they defined in their favor in the final quarter, which they dominated 25x18, after being tied at 39 points in the first half, and losing 18-21 in the third period.

The left-handed player from Havana, who wears the number zero on his back, contributed 10 points, three rebounds and a couple of assists, to reach a valuation of 13.

The member of the Cuban national team converted three baskets out of four possible field goals, one three-pointer in three attempts and four free throws out of seven, in 24 minutes and 43 seconds that he was on the court in the city of Bucharest.

Bosnian-Herzegovinian Andrija Stipanovic, with 14 points, and American Patrick Neal Richard, with seven rebounds and four assists, were the most outstanding players for Napoca.

U-Banca Transilvania, which is the undefeated leader of the Romanian National League, closes with this challenge the actions of the current year, and in their next game they will face Baschet Petrolul Ploiesti on Tuesday, January 4, also at home, in a duel corresponding to the 12th day of the league.

Cluj Napoca, with 11 undefeated victories, leads the 16-club league competition, seconded by Voluntari and Oradea, who share second place with 10-1.
