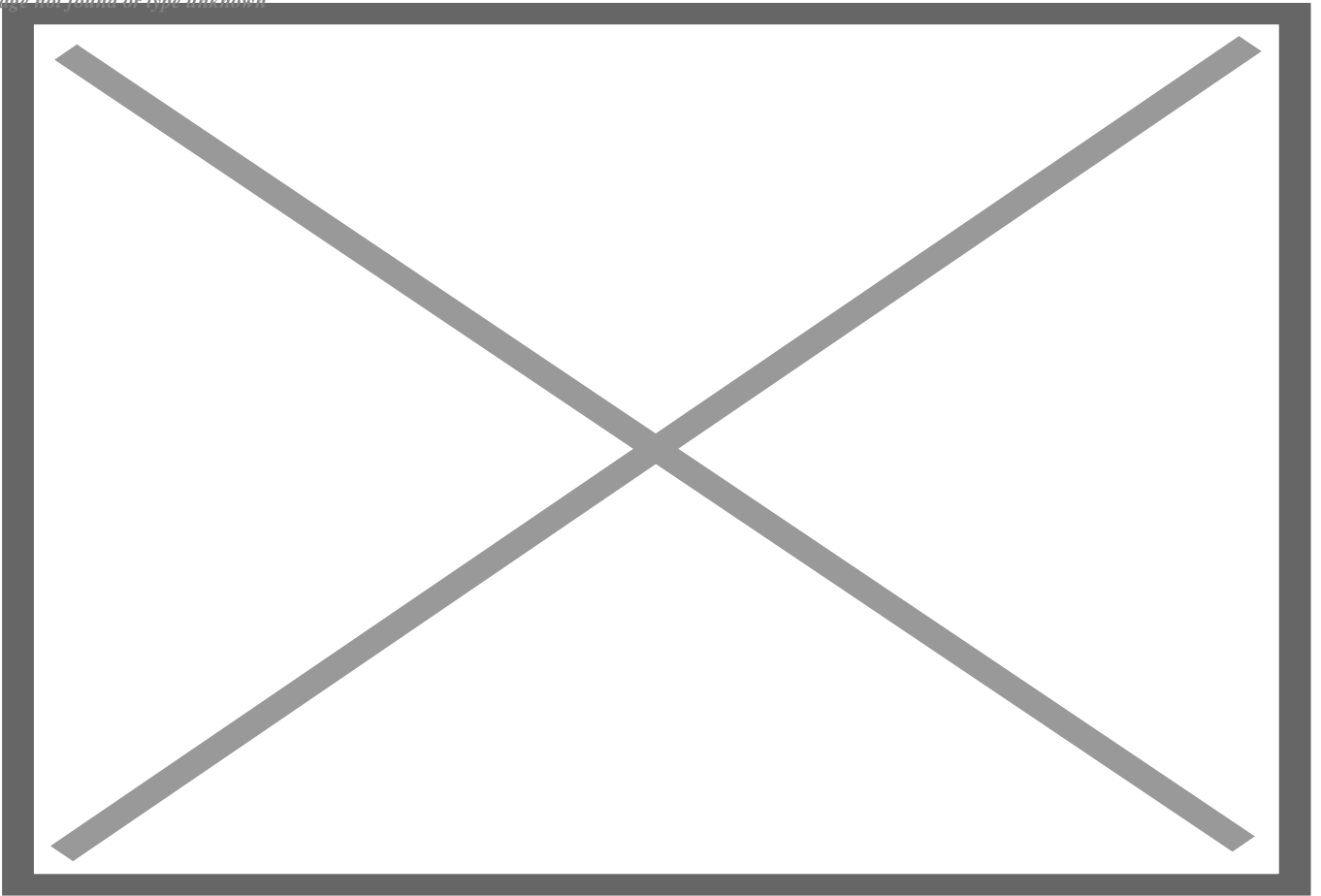


*Cuban Communist Party
