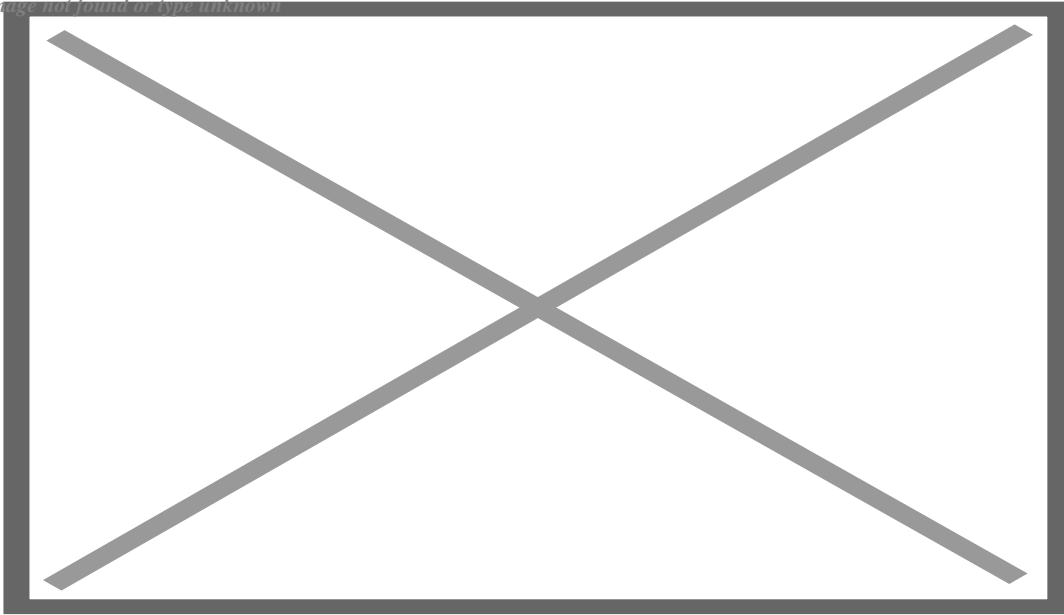


Vice-president of Algeria's Olympic Committee visits Cuba
