

Cuban President Raul Castro Receives World Health Organization Director General



Havana, July 15 (RHC) — Cuban President Raul Castro held talks on Monday with Dr. Margaret Chan, Director General of the World Health Organization (WHO), and Carissa Etienne, Director of the Pan American Health Organization (PAHO), who are visiting Cuba.

During the meeting, issues related to the 67th World Health Assembly, held last May in Geneva and chaired by Cuba, were addressed by the dignitaries.

The Millennium Development Goals; the post-2015 development agenda, as well as universal health coverage were also among the discussed topics.
