Mexican journalists interrupt congressional session

Mexico City, February 17 (RHC)-- In Mexico, journalists disrupted a session of Congress to denounce the assassinations of five reporters since the start of the year and to call for an end to impunity for killers. Protesters also held a minute of silence in honor of their slain colleagues.

Journalist José Reveles said: "The only way for these crimes not to be repeated is exemplary punishment for the culprits, be it hitmen, intellectuals, politicians in office or businessmen. Let them know that killing a

journalist has a cost.”
