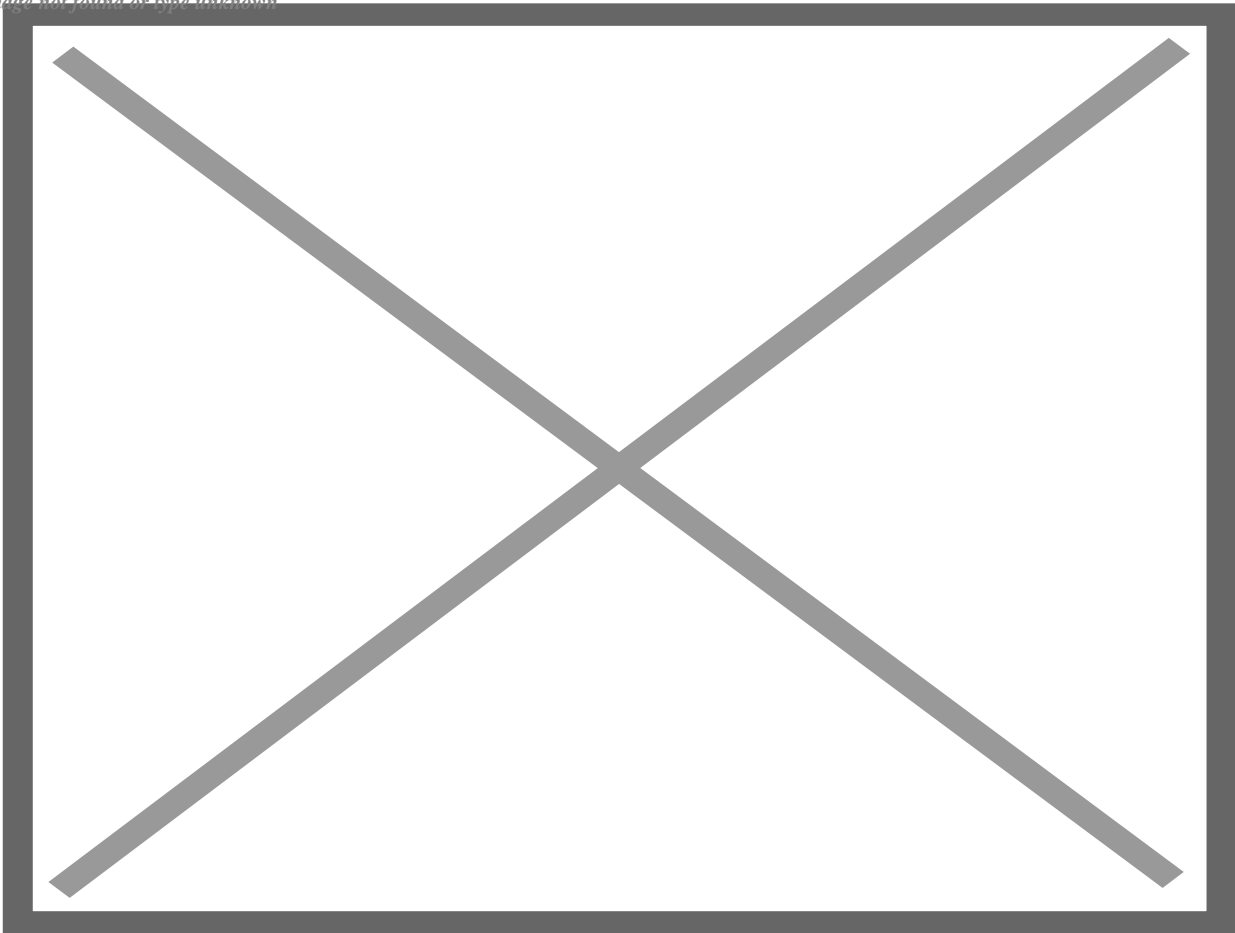


Children's exhibition in China pays tribute to Cuba

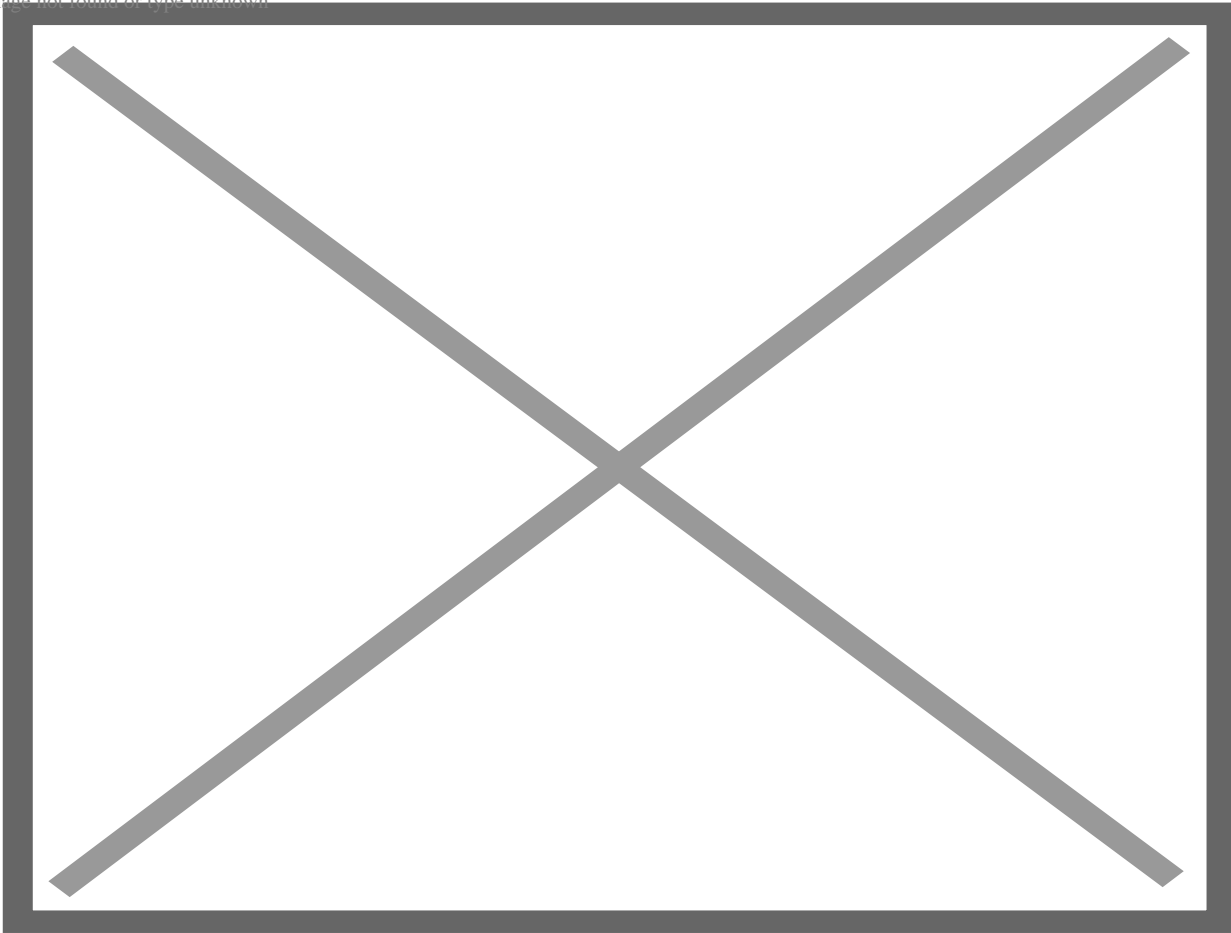


Exhibition dedicated to Cuba

Beijing, Feb. 21 (RHC)-- An exhibition of children's drawings was inaugurated in Beijing, China, as tribute to Cuba, highlighting its rich culture, nature and history. It comprises more than 30 works by children between the ages of 4 and 12 linked to the NGO Whiteless Arts Studio, headquartered in Beijing.

The initiative is part of a project promoted by the NGO, and which includes also the publication of several articles about Cuba and contacts with Russian tourists, who have visited the Caribbean island state, to speak about their experiences.
