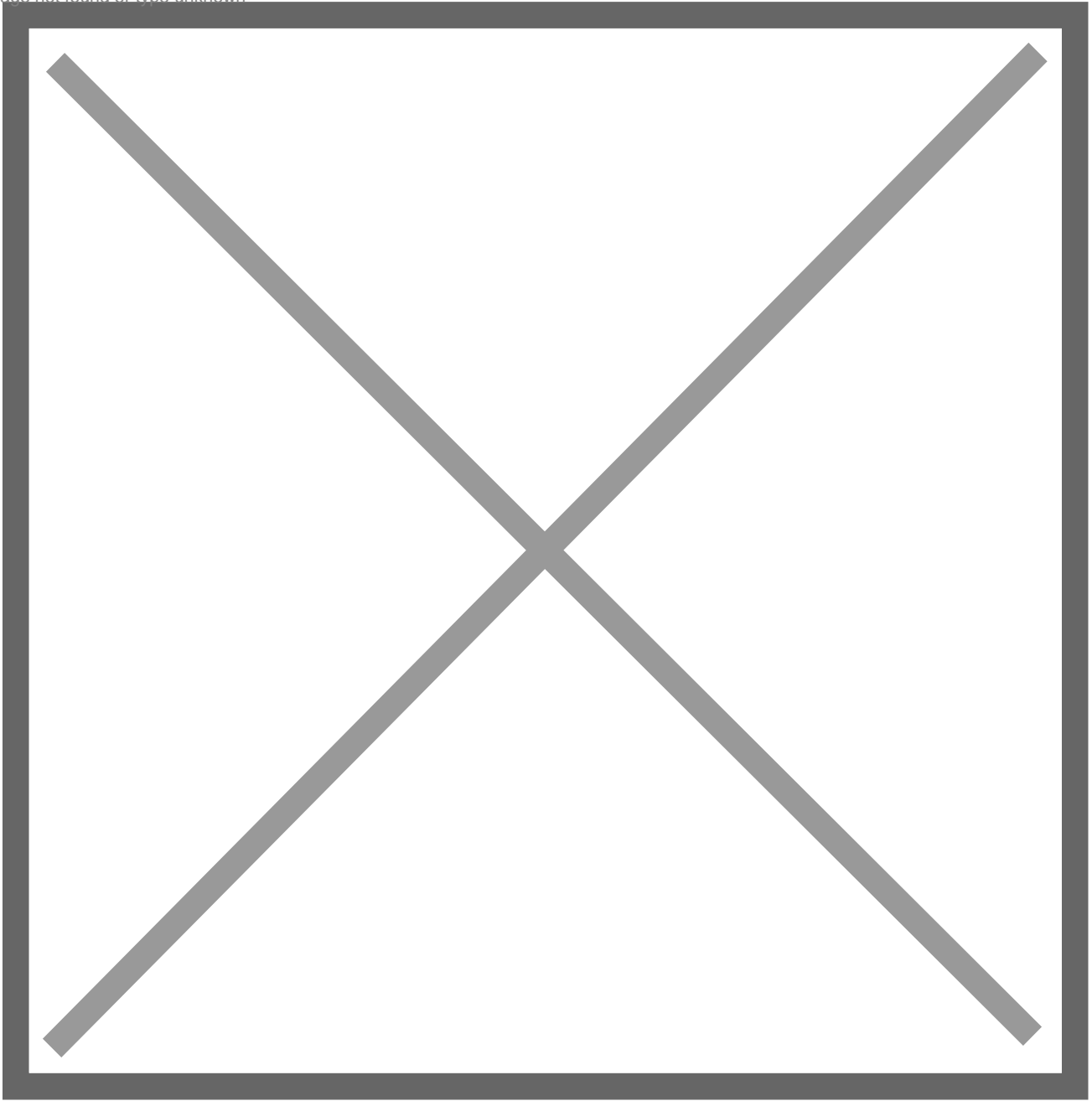


*Cuba's Public Health Minister
