
Huge cultural gala Corazon Feliz concludes children's activities in Havana



Havana, May 30 (RHC)-- With a huge cultural show featuring a refined production of excellent Cuban music and childen's theater performances, the "3rd International


Encounter of Songs for Children / Corazon Feliz" ended over the weekend in the Cuban capital.
