

Xi Jinping Congratulates Cuban People for Socialist Achievements



Havana, July 22 (RHC) — Chinese President Xi Jinping congratulated the Cuban people upon his arrival on official visit to Havana on Monday evening and said his visit will further strengthen bilateral friendship relations. He was welcomed at Havana's Jose Marti International Airport by Cuba's First Vice President Miguel Diaz-Canel.

During the visit of the Chinese president, Cuba and China will sign collaboration agreements in areas such as trade, agriculture, bio-technology, culture and education.

Upon his arrival, Xi told reporters that Cuba was the first Latin American and Caribbean nation to forge diplomatic relations with the New China, in 1960, opening a new chapter for China-Latin America ties.
