


Sixth Cuban mixed duo finishes in the world platform

Havana, July 2 (RHC)-- Cuban divers Anisley Garcia and Carlos Daniel Ramos finished sixth in synchronized diving from the 10-meter platform at the World Aquatic Sports Championships in Hungary.

The excellent result joins another sixth place and other outstanding performances of the representation of five Cuban divers in the competition taking place from June 17 to July 3 in the capital Budapest.

The Cubans totaled 263.91 points, the best of their five jumps was the last one (66.24) and the most complex was the third one, with 3.3 degree of difficulty, according to the statistics on the official website of the event.

The event was dominated by pairs from China, Ukraine and the United States, among nine pairs from America, Asia, Europe and Australia.

In this 19th edition of the World Aquatic Sports Championships, the five Cuban divers, both in springboard and platform, have been the most notable for Cuba, which also competed in the Hungarian capital in pool swimming and artistic swimming.
