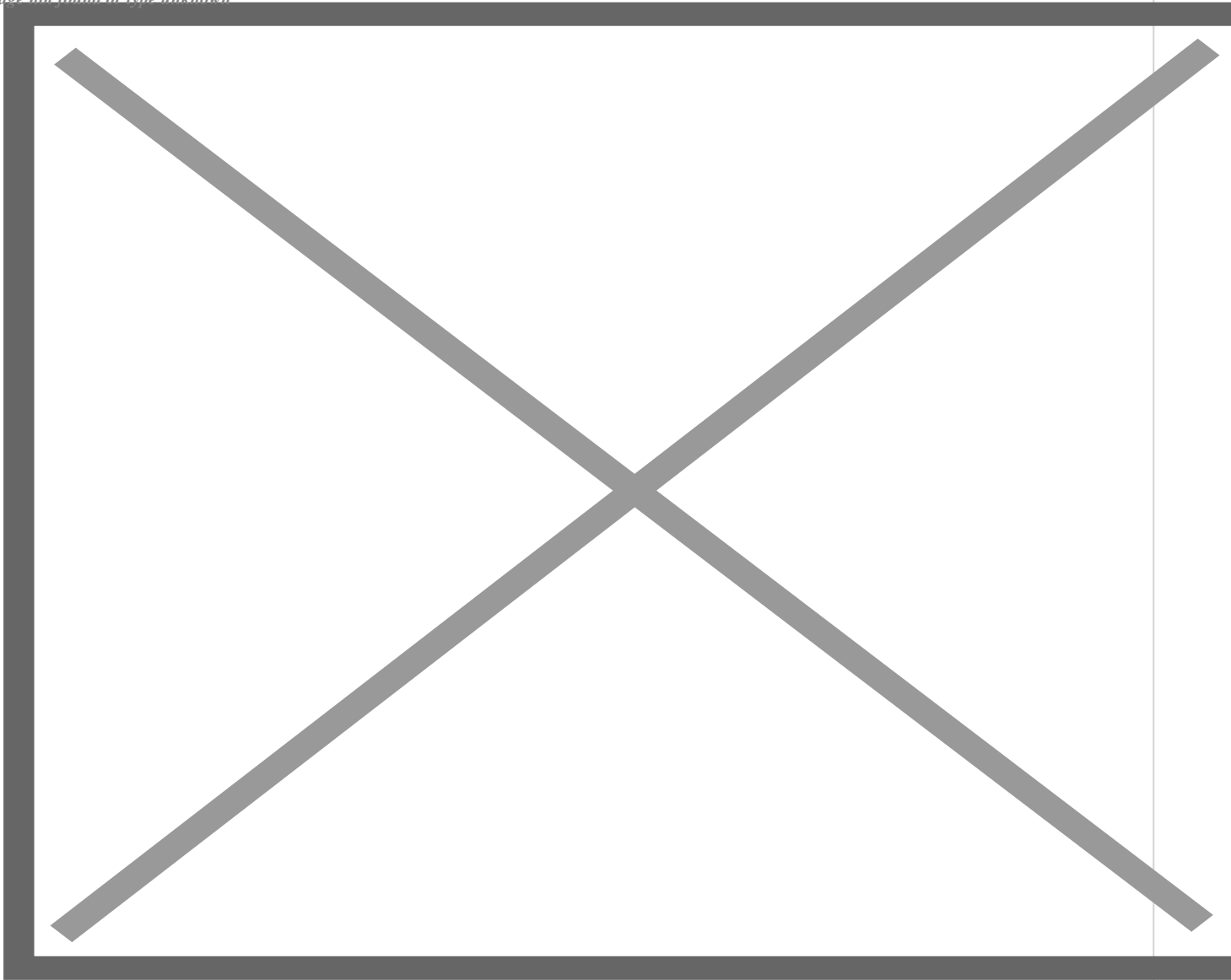


National Bike Ride Cuba for Peace in Cienfuegos

National Bike Ride Cuba for Peace in Cienfuegos

Cienfuegos, July 9 (RHC)-- The central-southern Cuban city of Cienfuegos was the main venue for the National Bike Ride 'Cuba for Peace' this Saturday, starting at 8:00 a.m., to celebrate the July

26th anniversary. The event was part of the "Summer for Everyone" -- "Verano para Todos."

Aylin Álvarez García, first secretary of the National Committee of the UJC, Union of Young Communists, the organization in charge of the activities, participated in the event.

There were more than two hundred bicycles taking part, with university students and workers, including those from the Cycling School.
