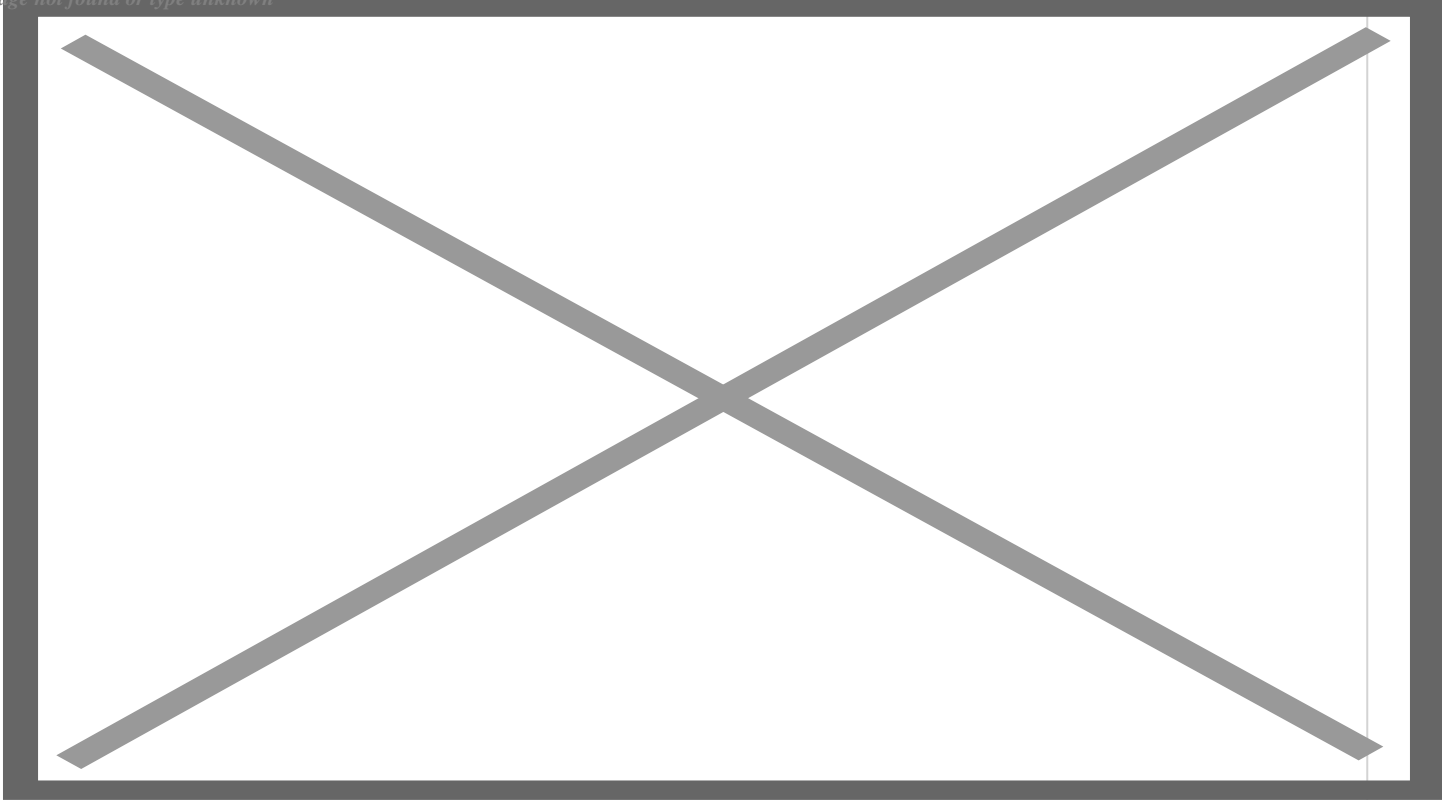


Swiss friends say Cuba is a small island with great people
