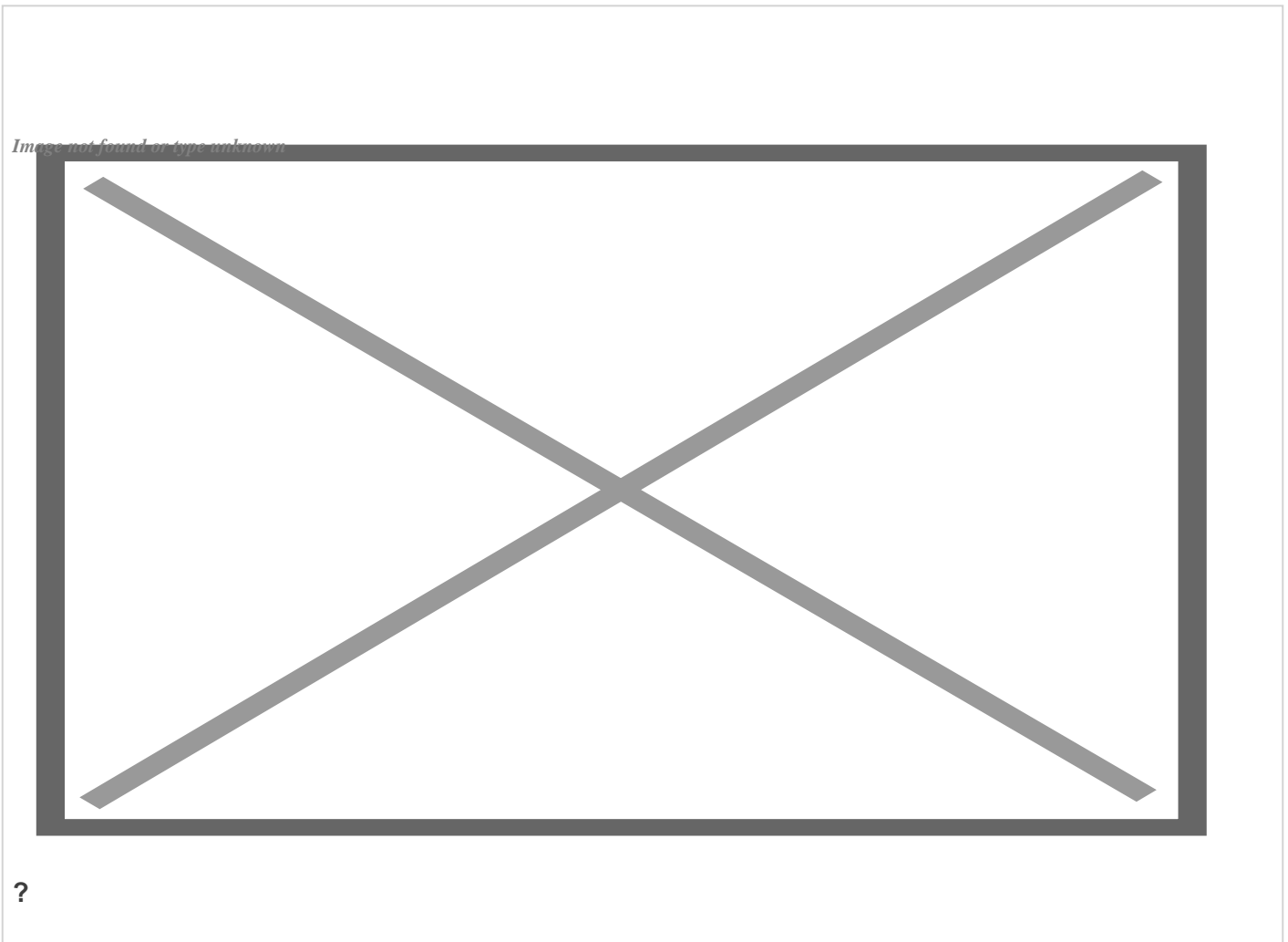


Raul Castro and Diaz-Canel lead ceremony for National Rebellion Day



Cienfuegos, July 26 (RHC)-- Army General and leader of the Cuban Revolution, Raúl Castro, and President Miguel Díaz-Canel, led the central act for the 69th anniversary of the assaults on the Moncada and Carlos Manuel de Céspedes Barracks.
