

Diaz-Canel Presides Over Political-Cultural Gala in Artemisa



Havana, July 26 (RHC), – The member of the Politburo and First Vice-president of the councils of State and Ministers, Miguel Diaz-Canel, presided over the political-cultural gala held on the occasion of activities to mark July 26 in Artemisa, venue of the main rally for the Day of National Rebellion.
