

Cuba Reiterates Unwavering Support for Venezuelan Revolution



Caracas, July 29 (RHC) -- Cuban First Vice President Miguel Diaz-Canel highlighted Monday in Caracas the unstoppable progress of the Bolivarian revolution under the leadership of Nicolás Maduro.
