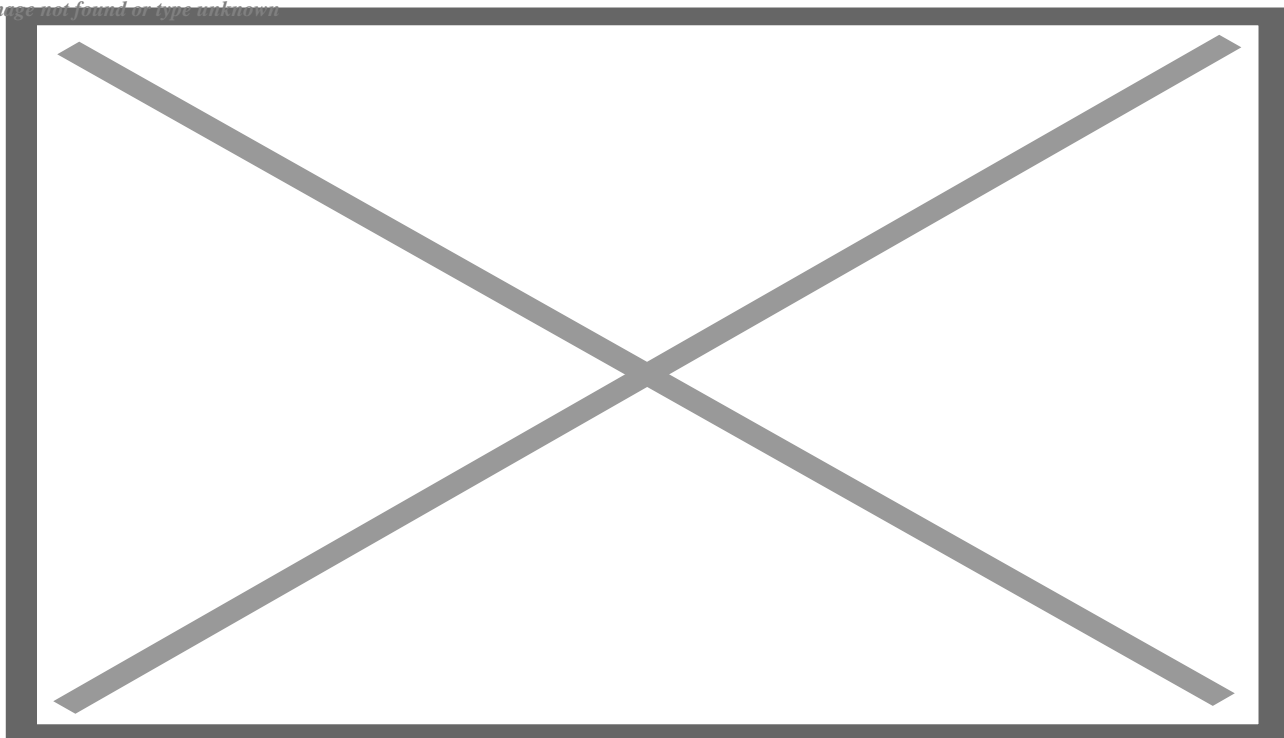


Cubans make their debut in Jalisco 2022 Hockey League
