
Good performance in communications in the recovery of Pinar del Río highlighted



Pinar del Río, October 23 (RHC)-- Communications Minister Mayra Arevich Marín highlighted last night in Pinar del Río the sector's progress in recovery, many days after the passage of Hurricane Ian, a phenomenon that caused serious damage to systems.

She added that the starting point was a well-designed diagnosis of the damages, which included poles, cables and downspouts, the latter being the link with customers in their homes both in the plains and in areas of difficult access in the mountains.

The Minister underlined that in Pinar del Río there are forces from all over the country and they work with discipline, organization and commitment of the men, that is why she ratified that progress has been made in the recovery.

Arevich Marín confirmed that this work is intensifying today in the capital of Pinar del Río, where ETECSA workers are working systematically and with great love.

The Minister of Communications, Mayra Arevich Marín, in her visit to Pinar del Río said that in the province there are workers of the sector who have been present in the territory during the passage of other atmospheric phenomena.

Something worth highlighting, she specified, is to see how in the face of difficulties such as these, men unite and the examples are in other groups such as the Post Office, which guaranteed the payment of the employees without electricity.

Later on, the Minister of Communications emphasized that they also guaranteed the delivery of postal packages, including the efforts of Radio Cuba to guarantee transmissions despite the loss of antennas.

Finally, Arevich Marín spoke about the Joven Club de Computación and Desoft in the effort to computerize the Offices of Attention to the Population and at the same time she praised the work of the Radio Amateurs.
