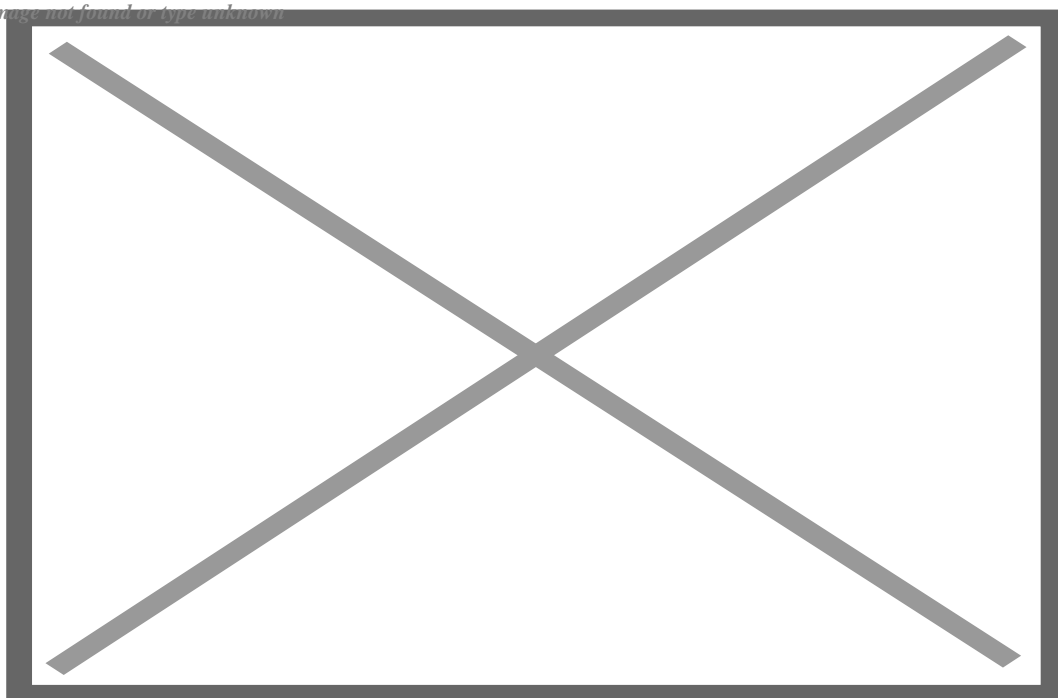


Bronze for Cuban women in Pelota Vasca World Championship in Biarritz

Havana, October 29 (RHC)-- Cubans Daniela Darriba and Yasmery Medina placed Cuba in the medal standings of the Biarritz 2022 World Absolute Pelota Vasca Championship, in France.

The Cubans defeated France's Coyos and Dutaret for the third step of the podium, in a very close match (15-11, 10-15 and 10-8) that took place at the Cassin fronton.

The work of the Cubans was very outstanding, especially because they repeated the performance of Barcelona 2018 after an extremely complex period due to the impact of covid-19 and other limitations.

In the preliminary stage of the competition, our team defeated the Argentines and Peruvians, and lost to the Spaniards. In the semifinals, they were unable to beat the Mexican favorites and focused on the

dispute for the bronze medal.

Their medal anchors as the 25th in the historical accumulated of Cuba, which now has two crowns, six subtitles and 17 bronze medals.

The other possibility of a medal for Cuba in this match was held by George Luis Barcelan and Dariel Leiva in the pairs trinquete match. However, they lost in two sets for third place to the Aztecs Moreno and Mundo, with scores of 15-5 and 15-0.
