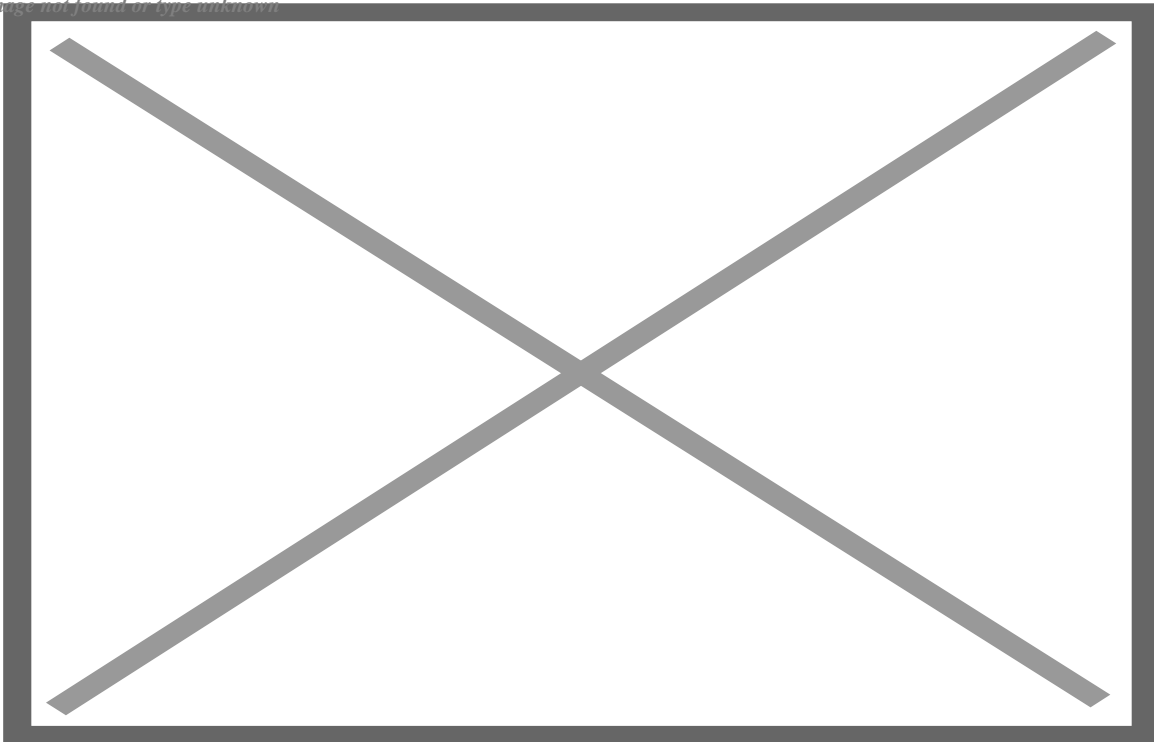


XX Scientific Convention on Engineering and Architecture opens in Havana
