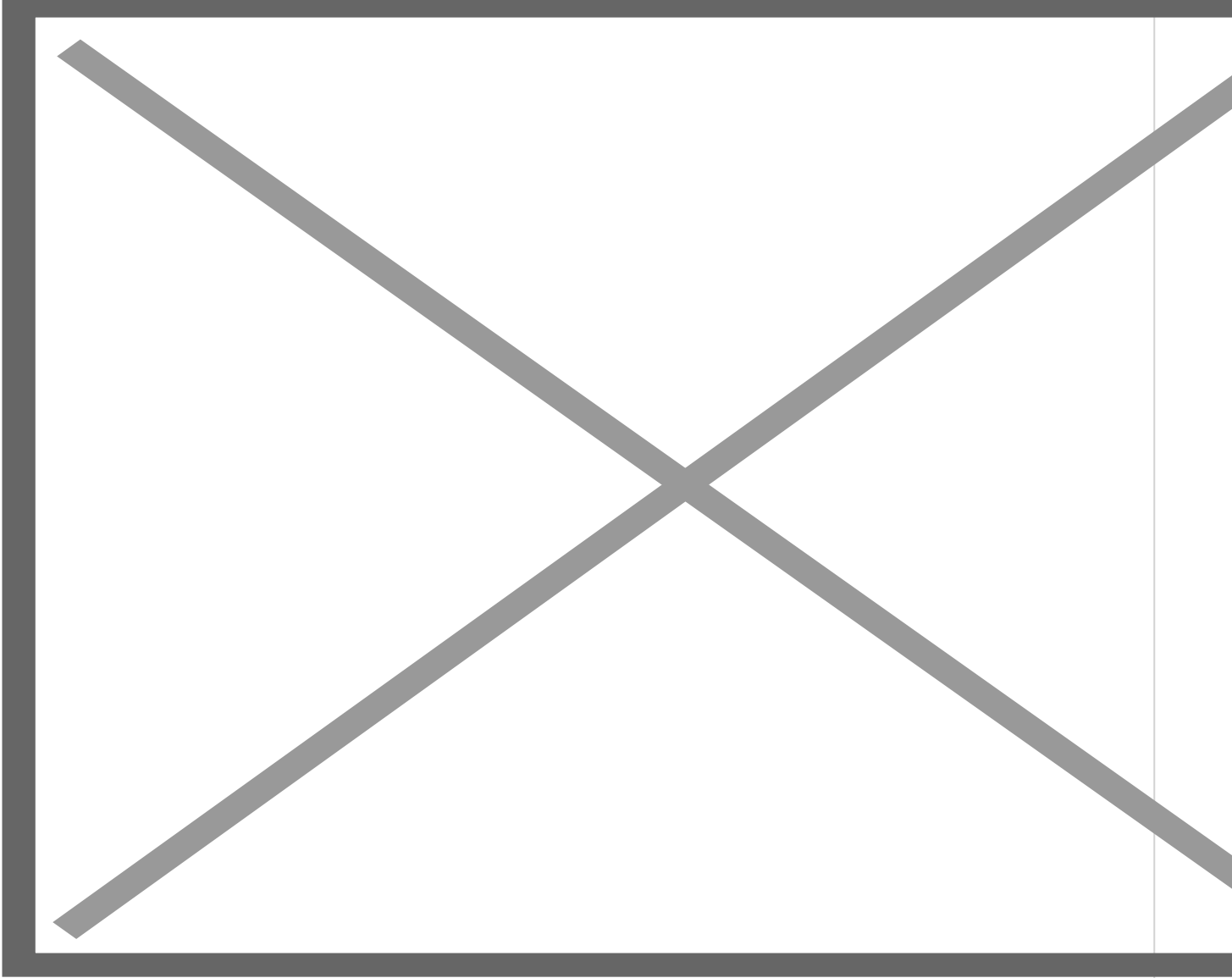


Raúl Castro and Díaz-Canel send floral offerings in popular tribute to Ronaldo Veitía
