

Arizona governor Doug Ducey agrees to dismantle illegal border wall

Phoenix, December 24 (RHC)-- Arizona Republican Governor Doug Ducey has reached an agreement with the federal government to dismantle his illegal, makeshift U.S.-Mexico border wall, built with double-

stacked shipping containers and razor wire.

Ducey's administration has spent over \$80 million on the project since August, which he said was needed to fill in the gaps left by former President Trump's incomplete border wall.

Governor Ducey has until January 4 to remove the barrier — one day before he leaves office.
