Havana, March 25 (RHC) The president of the Cuban Association of the United Nations, Norma Goicochea, highlighted the relevance of the 3rd World Forum on Human Rights that brought together more than 21,000 people from 98 countries in Buenos Aires to discuss the situation in Latin America and the world.

During the discussions, the members of the Forum analyzed neoliberalism's negative impact on democracy.
