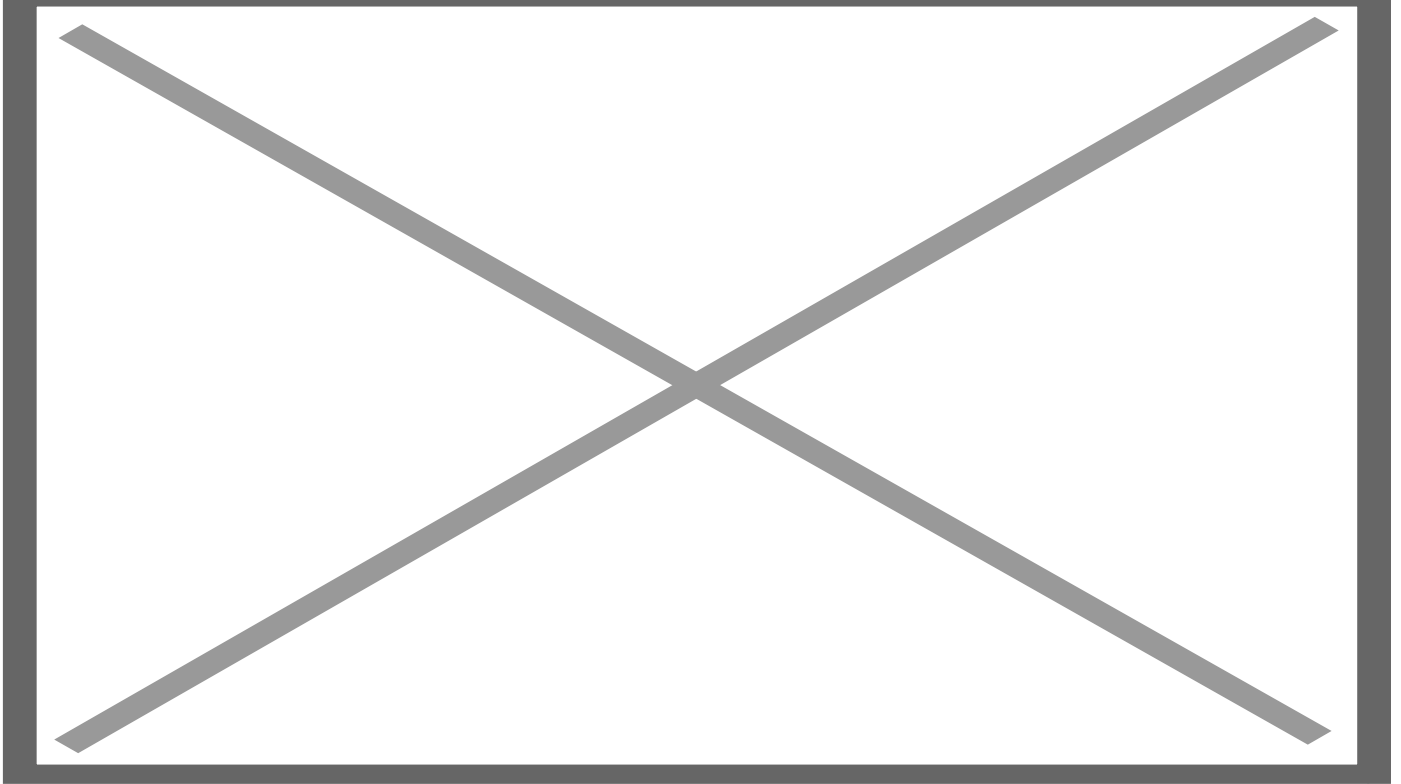


British Parliament opens investigation into Rishi Sunak for alleged conflict of interest
