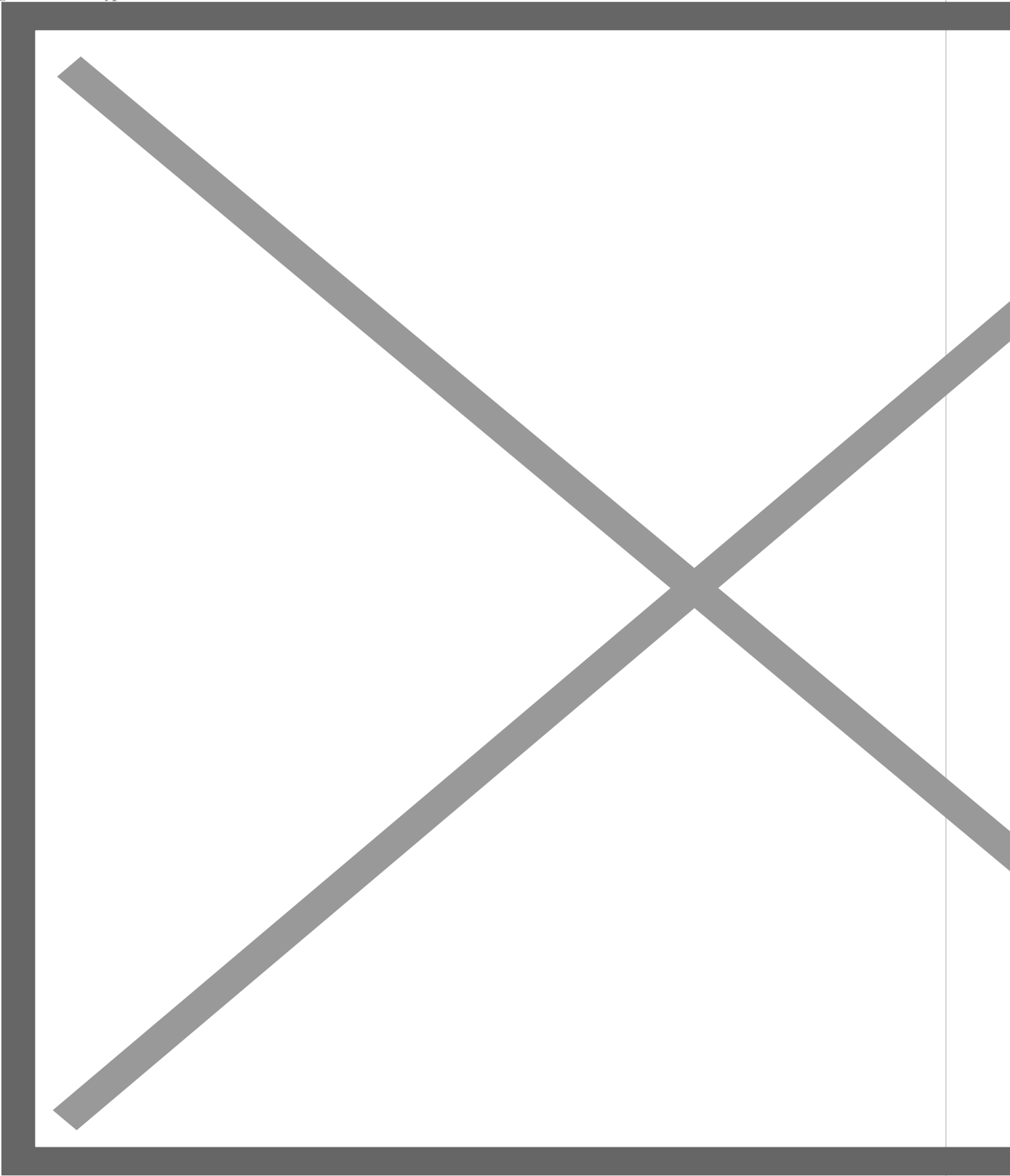


*Cuban president

Havana, April 25 (RHC)-- Cuban President Miguel Díaz-Canel received this Tuesday at the Palace of the Revolution his counterpart from Bosnia and Herzegovina, Željka Cvijanović.

During the official talks, the president of our country assured Cvijanović that her visit was long awaited.

He also ratified the willingness to expand political, economic, trade and cooperation relations between the two countries, the Presidency reported on its Twitter account.

For her part, Cvijanović said that her delegation visits the island as friends and highlighted the ample opportunities that are open to deepen bilateral ties.
