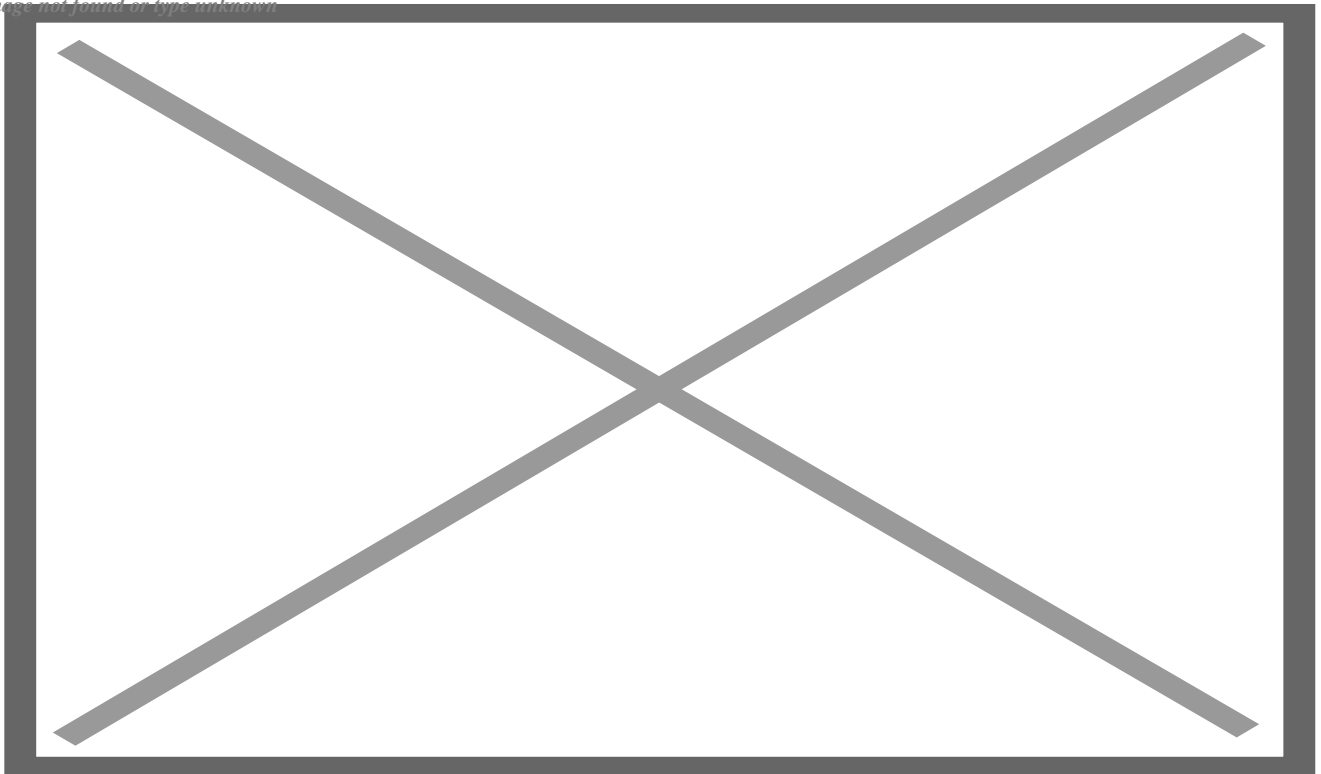


Díaz-Canel stresses importance of education for Cuba

Havana, May 6 (RHC)-- Cuban President Miguel Díaz-Canel today stressed the importance of education for the continuity of the Revolution, while speaking at the closing of the National Seminar for the Preparation of the 2023-2024 school year.

The head of state described the meeting as contributive and participatory, while reflecting that developing the next school year on schedule will be a great challenge and a strength.

"Let's make a new challenging course, in the development of education let's also put our hands and heart," Díaz-Canel said.
