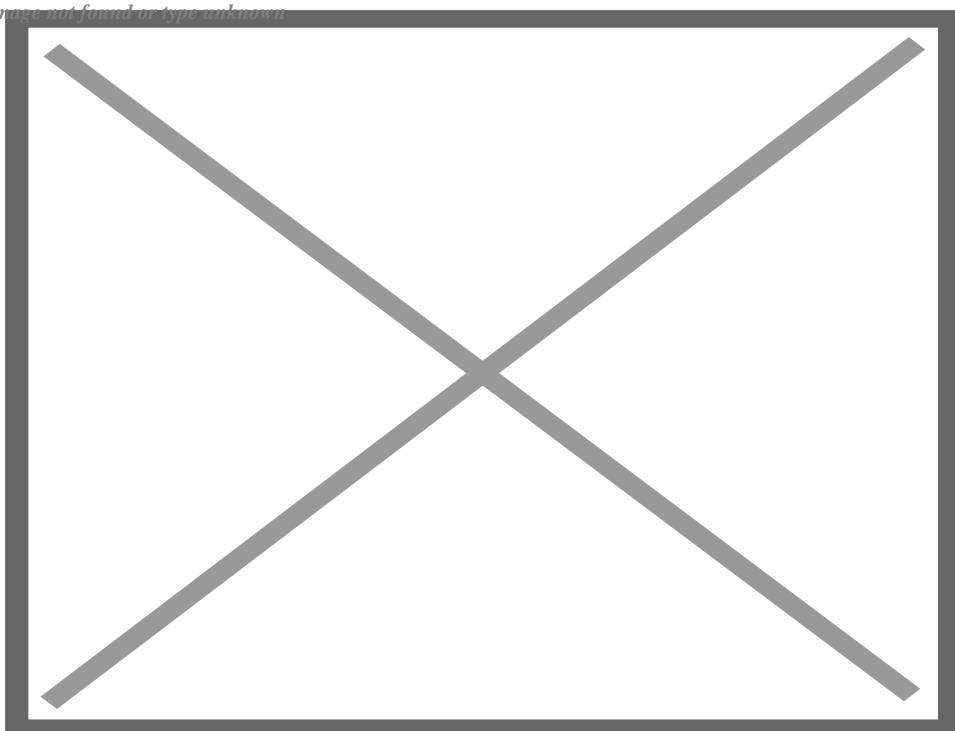

Havana, June 15 (RHC) The Federation of Cuban Women -FMC- on Thursday congratulated the Latin American news agency Prensa Latina on the 64th anniversary of its creation this June 16.
