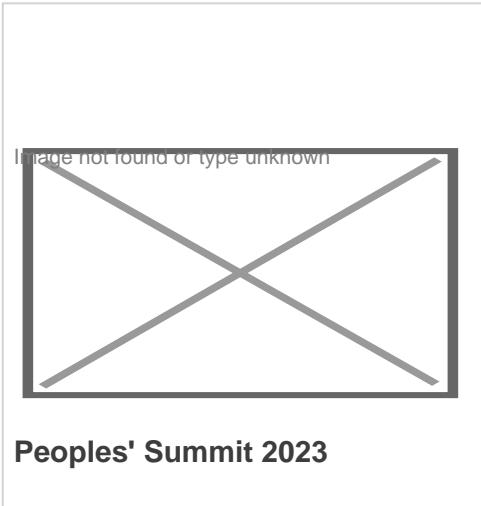


Cuban musician urges broad participation in Peoples' Summit 2023 in Brussels



Havana, July 7 (RHC)-- Singer-songwriter Israel Rojas, leader of popular Buena Fe duo urged goodwill people around the world to participate in the Peoples' Summit that will hold sessions in parallel to the Summit between the European Union (EU) and the Community of Latin America and Caribbean states (CELAC) in Brussels.

In a message posted on Twitter, Israel referred to the meeting of social organizations and movements.
