

President Díaz-Canel hails 508th anniversary of the founding of Santiago de Cuba

Havana, July 25 (RHC) -- Miguel Díaz-Canel, First Secretary of the Party Central Committee and President of the Republic, on Tuesday hailed the 508th anniversary of the founding of the city of Santiago

de Cuba, which will host the central event for the 70th anniversary of the Assaults on the Moncada and Carlos Manuel de Céspedes Barracks.

In a message on the social network Twitter, the head of state congratulated the people of that city, and affirmed that they are always rebellious, hospitable and heroic.
