

Cuba's prime minister inaugurates moringa powder plant in Pinar del Rio

Havana, August 19 (RHC)-- Cuba's Communist Party of Cuba (CC-PCC) Central Committee Political Bureau member and Prime Minister Manuel Marrero Cruz inaugurated on Saturday in the western province of Pinar del Río, the plant for processing moringa for medicinal purposes and as a nutritional

supplement.

Located in the Unidad de Base Productiva (UBP) 'El Pitirre', in the municipality of Los Palacios, it is estimated that the plant will process and obtain about 20 tons of moringa powder every year.
