
Cuba and China Discuss Communist Party's Role in Development



Beijing, September 10 (RHC) -- Officials from China and Cuba's ruling Communist Parties held a theory seminar on Wednesday to discuss the Communist Party's role in China's reform and Cuba's "update" of its economic model.
