


Bellingham saved Madrid against Celta

Madrid, August 26 (PL) Real Madrid beat Celta de Vigo by one goal to nil in an early match of the third round of the Spanish soccer league, where it will continue as leader until the next one.

English midfielder Jude Bellingham was once again on the scoreboard in the 81st minute with his fourth goal in three games, and has been the great responsible for the leadership of Los Blancos.
