


Cuban sports system supports the cause of Palestine

Havana, October 23 (JIT)-- Officials and workers of INDER, representing the Cuban sports system, ratified their solidarity with the heroic and brotherly people of Palestine in a special morning meeting held on Monday in areas near the Sports City Coliseum.

The event was headed by the first vice president of INDER, Raul Fornes Valenciano, and the First Secretary of the Committee of the Communist Party of Cuba in the Hill, Yosvany Cañete, along with other officials of institutions subordinate to the central sports body in the Greater of the Antilles.

Antonio William Suarez, secretary general of the PCC committee, on behalf of the militancy of the organization, workers and athletes, as well as all those who belong to the Cuban sports system, demanded the Israeli government the immediate ceasefire and the inhuman attacks on the Palestinian people.

"We Cubans are faithful to the legacy and principles of our Commander in Chief Fidel Castro Ruz, who was a standard bearer of internationalism and solidarity with all the peoples of the world," he said.
